NAVIGATING YOUR SPORTSENGINE PROFILE

TIP: SportsEngine pages are different for every user! They are designed "for you (only)!"

- This is cool, in that you get a personalized experience
- But it can be difficult, because (you) can't always "see" what others "see"

•

• To access the information at SportsEngine, you'll need to learn to navigate your profile.

First, Log-in at https://user.sportngin.com/users/sign in?

- Notice that your initials appear top-left on this "home" page
- To get to your profile, click on the "Household" term in the left column
- On your household page you'll see "tiles" on the right side.
- Click on yours. That takes you to your "Profile Page."

At the Profile Page, there's an editable "profile tile" on the left (basic name, birthdate stuff)

- On the right though, there are two tiles. The top is your profile at RMR, the lower, at USAV
- You might want to open each of them, to see what they offer
- Also, notice the "wallet" icon at top right of each tile.
- The wallet gives you access to digital membership cards (apple or google)

But most importantly, click "VIEW DETAILS" at the bottom of the RMR tile.

• Now you're on your "**Profile Details**" page.

This page offers two important tabs up top as well as the blue **Academy** Button (top right)

"Membership" will display *each* membership type that you have (coach, player, referee, etc.)

- Don't stress if you see some "expired" memberships; those are usually previous years
- DO look for youur current-year membership
- Click the small arrow at left to expand the details of that membership
- If you haven't completed a requirement, that will show in RED
- Off to the right of that requirement should be a blue hyperlink to FIX it
- Follow that link to sign the waiver, or take the course, or start the screen... whatever

The Academy can be accessed by clicking the blue button at the top-right of your "Details" tile

- Click around to find various courses that you might be interested in
- Many will offer credit if you pass the quizzes embedded in the module
- Look especially for any modules with the code "RM-..." since those are "ours"
- After you pass the RMR-23, for example, your Team Roster will show "SR" (Regional Scorer)!
