

Brian C. Stone Memorial Christmas Hockey Tournament

Welcome players, family and hockey fans to the 39th annual high school hockey tournament at the JFK Coliseum in Manchester. We appreciate your support of this tourney, an event that honors a friend of our local hockey community, and a legend of New Hampshire hockey, Brian C. Stone.

Coach Stone was a long-time player, coach and mentor, and a beloved son, brother, husband, father and friend. Coach Stone passed suddenly in March 2018, at the age of 51. He had just finished the season as assistant coach of Trinity High School's hockey team. Over the course of his career, Coach Stone also served on the coaching staff of Memorial High School's hockey team, and as head coach for Central High School hockey.

He grew up playing hockey for the Manchester Flames, and went on to play for Central High School and New England College. His skill, passion and commitment earned him induction into the New England College Athletic Hall of Fame in 2001, the Queen City Hall of Fame in 2002, the NH Legends of Hockey in 2006, and for the 2013-14 season, he was voted Coach of the Year by the New Hampshire High School Hockey Coaches Association. Coach Stone felt the most important role he played was as a mentor to his players. He encouraged them to volunteer and help others in the community, and reminded them often that the only things they could control in life were attitude and effort. In 2018, this annual high school hockey tournament was formally re-named the Coach Brian C. Stone Memorial Christmas Hockey Tournament.

Our lead sponsor, Brady Sullivan Properties, returns this year to help carry on the proud tradition of high school hockey over the holiday break, a tradition that will always carry a special remembrance for our friend, Coach Stone.

Tournament History

Thirty-seven years ago, Manchester Memorial High School Hockey Coach Hubie McDonough Jr. and Manchester Central High School Hockey Coach Wally Tafe Jr. had a holiday wish- that their hockey teams could play more than the NHIAA regular season schedule of 18 games. In 1981, that wish morphed into the first Manchester High School Christmas Hockey Tournament, with four teams competing against each other. McDonough's Memorial High School Crusaders took the title of Tournament Champions that first year.

The popular tournament expanded to eight teams, with Manchester's "original four" Central, Memorial, Trinity and West competing against local and regional high schools. It was often referred to as "Manchester's Bean Pot".

The tourney hit a rough patch with the unexpected loss of its primary sponsor, and the Manchester High School Christmas Tournament was no more. Fast-forward to 2010, when a group of hockey enthusiasts, spearheaded by George 'Butch' Joseph, formed a committee to resurrect the tournament. Since then, the volunteer committee, thanks to the generosity of sponsors, has successfully organized and run the tournament year after year.

This year's lead sponsor Brady Sullivan Properties, helps carry on the proud tradition of high school hockey over the holiday break, a tradition that now brings with it a special remembrance for our friend, Coach Stone.

Coach Stone "Stoney"

Brian C. Stone stepped outside the traditional coaching style to provide the players with a positive growth opportunity through 3D coaching.

On the ice, he coached sportsmanship and conduct, but off the ice he aspired to provide guidance and mentorship through "life lessons".

"Life lessons" were planned group time with an educational purpose. Through various discussions players were given a topic to research and present its effect on them personally.

This is why ATTITUDE and EFFORT have become a foundation of Coach Stone's legacy.

Thank you to all the sponsors and volunteer committee members for their dedication to the success of this tournament.

We are very honored that in Brian's memory the tradition of this event continues.

Brian Stone strived to be more than just a coach. He wanted to share his wisdom and make a positive influence in the lives of these young men.

Brian accomplished this through his love and passion for the sport of Ice Hockey.

Round Robin

Groups will play Round Robin format. All games will be played until a winner is determined. Teams will be awarded two points for a win and zero points for a loss. Total points will determine the final group seeding. The #1 seed team from each Group advances to the Championship Game. Each team will be allotted one timeout per game.

Tournament Tie Breakers

- Head to Head
- 2. Most Wins
- 3. Fewest Goals Allowed
- Quickest goal scored
- 5. Coin Toss

If there is a three or four team tie, the tie-breaking procedure will be used until a highest seed is awarded.

Regulation Ties / Overtime

If the score is tied at the end of regulation time the following will apply after a two minute intermission:

Teams defend the same end as the end of regulation.

A five-minute sudden-death overtime period will be played 4 on 4.

If the game remains tied after overtime:

A 3-man alternating shootout will take place.

It will be the Home Team's choice to shoot first or second.

Should the game remain tied after the 3-man shootout, a sudden-death shootout will continue with each team allowed one shooter per round until a winner is determined.

No player may shoot twice until every player on the team has shot.

Any player in the Penalty Box at the end of overtime will be INELIGIBLE for the Shoot Out.

The championship game ONLY, will not end in a shoot out. If the score is tied at the end of regulation the following will apply after a two minute intermission:

A five-minute overtime will be played 4 on 4. If the game remains tied: 3 on 3 play will commence until there is a winner.

Running time-6 goal differential in the 3rd period.






