


BYHA 4-Wheeler Raffle Winner is....

Board of Directors Nominations Reminder

There are 3 Board seats that will be up for election this year, and all are for 3 year terms. As a reminder, below is the nomination procedure to run for an open Board seat per our Bylaws:

In order to be eligible to vote, nominate someone, or hold a BYHA Board position, you must:

- Be a BYHA Association member in good standing as stated in Article VI; and
- Be 18 years of age or older as of the date of the election; and NOT
- Be eligible to run for a Board position, or be a Board member in any other hockey association.

Section 2: Nominations:

The Board of Directors nominations shall be held at the March meeting only.

Nominations will not be accepted after the March regularly scheduled Board meeting. Written or verbal nominations will be accepted. At the end of the March meeting, the list of nominees will be officially placed on the election ballot. Nomination reminders will be published in the February and March newsletters. A written explanation as to why a nominee would like to be on the Board of Directors should be included with the nomination, which will then be published in the April monthly newsletter. This explanation is not to exceed 1 page in length.



January Board Meeting



Gambling Report:

- Revised returns have been completed and submitted.
- We made a little money this month. Profits are still being affected because of accountant expenses.
- Estimated expenditures for next month are \$58,500.
 Cathie motioned to approve the estimated expenditures; Bill seconded; motion carried unanimously.
- We have been reported to the CRG (disciplinary board of gambling) and will go before them some time in February.
- Tom requested that another Board member attend the gambling training.
- All profits from the 4-wheeler raffle will be donated to the hockey association.

The meeting was called to order at 7:43 PM.

President's Report:

- Buffalo Hockey Hall of Fame ceremony was this past weekend. It was a very nice ceremony that meant a lot to those inducted. Thank you to all involved.
- The Kopp Family Foundation donated \$1,000 to BYHA on behalf of Steve Triplett's induction into the Hall of Fame.
- Paula Stewart donated \$1,000 to BYHA on behalf of her family, in memory of her husband Dan Stewart, on the occasion of his induction into the Hall of Fame.

• Secretary's Report:

— Bruce motioned to approve the minutes from last month's; Bill seconded; motioned carried unanimously.

• Treasurer's Report:

- A reminder, BYHA only prorates ice fees based on the length of a major injury, with supporting documentation.
- Bruce requested from Pam a financials overview to review BYHA's cash flow. She will provide this to the board next month.

• Registration Report:

- All rosters were completed December 30, 2006.
- We have approximately 460 players including both Jr. Gold teams.

• Tournament Report:

- Emails have gone out to solicit volunteers.
- This weeks' tournament will have 16 teams.
- The Peewee tournament later this month is still open and we need to get more teams.
- March Squirt A/B tournament is still open and we are actively looking for additional teams.

Manager Report:

- N/A

• Equipment Report:

- We are still waiting on practice jerseys and Jr. Gold goalie size jerseys.
- Gary Ramsey will take orders for apparel for the remainder of this season. Next season we will send out a Request for Proposal (RFP) for bids on apparel sales, etc. and a vendor will be selected at that time (approximately March or April).

• District 5 Report:

- The usual officer's reports were made without incident.
- All rosters have been signed. A new system will be implemented next season since this year was such a hassle. More on that later.
- Reminder to all coaches to please take it easy on the officials. The younger officials have received more than their share of flack from coaches. No specifics were given here, just an overall reminder/request.
- There was no discussion regarding the by-law changes. Since the changes are all housekeeping issues it seems as though everyone will vote for the changes.
- The weather policy came up for discussion. When is a game called off due to weather or driving conditions? The short answer was, "it's on the web site look it up". The next question was, "what is the web site address?" The District 5 web site address is: www.district5.pucksystems.com The weather policy is as follows:

"If weather conditions seem hazardous to highway travel and a coach questions the feasibility of traveling within the District 5 area, the following procedures should be followed:

1) The traveling coach must call Tim Sweezo in the East (952-473-5528) or Tim Hanson in the West (320-235-9472) (The West shall consist of Litchfield, Hutchinson, Cold Spring, Paynesville, Willmar, and Sartell.) (Buffalo is in the East.) 2) It MUST be a coach or team manager that calls; NOT a parent.

Mr. Sweezo and Mr. Hanson will retrieve information on travel advisories and make a decision on the game in question. If it is decided that the game should be played, and isn't, the game will be recorded as a forfeit. The traveling team will be fined for not playing the league game.

January Board Meeting



- Reminder that rescheduling of games must be approved and completed at least 7 days in advance of the game.
- The officials association is working on a system to charge a \$25 fee for each game that is cancelled and the referees are not notified in a timely manner. "A timely manner" has not yet been defined. It ranged from 14 days to "not at the last minute". More to follow on this issue.
- Mite jamborees are intended to be for 2nd year mites only. This is a general rule and guideline and does not seem to be enforced. No more discussion on this matter.
- BYHA did not have any missing score sheets however we were assessed fees for game and/or roster changes.

Metro Report:

- Wes Barrett award short list (of 5) was created.
 None of these 5 candidates were from District 5.
- Created a short list of the Made It Happen Award
 for a long-standing proponent for Junior Gold –
 there are 3 candidates.
- Buffalo White (older team) is ranked 4th in the Let's Play Hockey ranking (of 24 teams) at the Junior B level.
- Scholarship packets were handed out to each team in District 5; players can apply through MN Hockey.

Hockey Operations Report:

- A mid-season coaches meeting was held Monday, January 8th. All teams with the exception of U10A (Jim Rooney was out of town), U14A, and Bantams B2 were in attendance. The following tops were discussed:
- Skill clinics and skill development at practices (Coach MacMillan)
- 2. Attendance and mandatory use of scheduled dryland times.
- 3. Disciplinary issues within certain teams and how they were handled.

Issues such as team sizes, ice times, etc. will be discussed at year-end meeting and suggestions forwarded to both HOC and Buffalo Administration Board. Below is a short recap of the teams' seasons that were in attendance:

<u>U12B</u> (Cory Carlson): Team is making strides and at the same time having fun. Current record is 6-5.

<u>U12A</u> (Ken Basten): 6-3-1 is league. Team just came off tournament in Brainerd with the championship!!

<u>U14A</u>: Team is improving and currently in 4th place; this, with a couple of 1st year skaters.

Squirt B1 (Dan O'Neill): Won their 1st game last Saturday. Team is improving each practice.

Squirt B2 (Tom McDonald): Record is currently 5-1 record.

Squirt B3 (Dale Gilmer): 4-1 record and showing improvement

<u>Squirt B4</u> (John Daugherty): Winning some games with very young team – improving and having fun.

Squirt A (Steve Bruhn and Eric Lindvall): 6-0 league record. Team is playing very good hockey. 7 of the 11 skaters are 2nd year squirts.

<u>Peewee B2</u> (Erich Reineck): Team is improving as season goes on. Recent loss to MAML 2-0 could have easily been a victory. Attendance problems are improving.

<u>Peewee B1</u> (Pete Kist): 7-1 in district according to Pete, needs to be more competitive outside D5.

<u>Peewee A</u>: 12-1-1 in district, 1-5 outside district. Team needs to also compete at a higher level outside D5. Team playing better, as a team, than earlier in the year.

<u>Bantam B2</u> (Heath Warnsholtz): Team is 4-6 in district play. Team competed very well in Osseo tournament this past weekend beating Hermantown after a couple 1-goal losses.

<u>Bantam B1</u> (Dave Carothers): 12-6-1 overall team improving as they get all players back. Team was down to 8 skaters for a period of time due to injuries and discipline actions.

Bantam A (Bob Jernberg): Slow start in districts 0-3-2. Since then, 7-1 overall district record 7-4-2. The team is improving, working hard, and seeing some benefits of their hard work. Waivered-in goalie, Ben Myers, has had 4 shutouts and recently beat his former team, Mound, where he had been cut – 6-3.

Mid-season questionnaires will be given to coaches to go over with players individually over the next couple weeks.

Sponsor Report:

 Scott got 2 more team sponsors. He is working on organizing banner printing and getting Bison season tickets to the sponsors.

S.K.A.T.E. (Skaters Keep Achieving Through Education

Skaters Keep Achieving Through Education (S.K.A.T.E.) is beginning its' 6th season in Minnesota. This exciting academic achievement program recognizes the efforts of student athletes that play hockey.

This program is designed to encourage student athletes to maintain good grades while participating in youth hockey, and to reward their academic performance. It is also endorsed by MN Hockey and is open to all players that are in 3rd grade and above. The

program begins at the end of August of each year.

Participation is easy and voluntary. You simply have to submit copies of your child's report cards for the 2 periods during the school and hockey season (i.e.: For children on trimesters, it will be the first 2 report cards; for children on quarters, it will be the 2nd and 3rd quarters).

Simply drop off the player's report cards in the lock box labeled "BYHA S.K.A.T.E. Coordinator" located in the new arena. The period for submitting report cards is from February 1st, 2007 through March 25th, 2007. The deadline for submitting report cards is March 25th, 2007 and cannot be extended.

Players need to maintain a 3.0/"B" grade point average or better during the reporting period (or an "S" average where "A" to "F" grades are not used). No incomplete grades are allowed during the grading period. Report cards will be utilized to only determine Grade Point Average, and S.K.A.T.E. will respect all laws and privileges for privacy. All information will be kept strictly confidential.
