Gambling Report:

- Thona will submit the corrective action plan later this week.

- There is currently \$47,348 outstanding in ice bills.
- We currently owe the City of Buffalo \$111,560 for 3 months of ice bills.
- Pam requested \$62,307 from the gambling fund for ice bills (as it becomes available).
- Cathie motioned to approve this amount from the gambling fund to the general fund; John seconded; motion carried unanimously.
