





September Board Meeting



Gambling Report:

- July net income of \$29,000; net less expenses was \$12,500.
- August data has been given to the accountant. Thona was hoping we'll be able to net approximately \$6000-\$7000 for August. Summer is typically a slower time for pull-tabs.
- Jaci Gladden is working at developing a bonus program so the pull-tab sellers are motivated to increase deposits.
- The storage locker was cleaned out.
- Thona requested \$400 for BYHA to join Allied Charities that lobbies for nonprofit organizations.
- Thona requested approval for change in expenses. Cathie motioned to approve these; John seconded; motioned carried unanimously.
- Thona requested \$34,750 for this next month's gambling expenses. Cathie motioned to approved this; John seconded; motioned carried unanimously.

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 PM.

• President's Report:

— Tom reminded the board that the extra meetings regarding finances have been stressful for all. There are going to be many questions in the next few weeks regarding this. Board members are to do what they can to ensure there is one consistent, accurate message given to all BYHA members.

• Secretary's Report:

- July meeting minutes were lost in transition from meeting-minute taker to Cathie. So Cathie included the gambling summaries in September's newsletter.
- Brenda motioned to approve the meeting minutes as printed in last month's newsletter; John seconded; motion approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report:

- Pam distributed revised financials. There were questions regarding tournament fees; as they appeared to be over budget at this time. BYHA teams have been registered for tournaments that we may back out of. Jim Rooney and Bob Jernberg are going to meet to discuss and finalize the list of tournaments BYHA teams will participate in.
- BYHA received a phone call from the IRS regarding scheduling an audit of our 2004-2005 financials for both gambling and general accounts.
- We had to pay a \$2,700 fee to the US Treasury for the penalty for the late audit this year.
