

Gambling Report:

Profit of \$10,766.51 for the month of October. Request for expense coverage at \$34,450.00 for November expenses. Request for additional expense for additional meat raffle prizes of \$1,348.25 and \$600 for Larson Allen.

Leslie motioned to approve the gambling report. Donnie 2nd. Motion passed unanimously. Leslie also motioned to approve additional expenditures for a total of \$1,948.25 for October. Donnie 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

• Secretary's Report:

Donnie motioned to approve the secretary's report, Bill 2nd, motion passed unanimously.

• Treasurer Report:

Seth James and Cindy Trousdale estimate that we made about \$1,500 at the college game. Special thanks to Seth and Cindy for all their hard work!

Cheryl will talk to city to try to reduce finace charges and pay ice through September.

Registration Report:

"Pay Later" options has been turned off, registering players must pay by credit card to complete registration process. Jr. Gold final registration is Saturday November 22, 9:00 – 10:30am in the Buffalo Civic Center Community Room.

Roster signing went well—only 4 redlines. All redlines have been corrected and supplemental rosters have been submitted to D5. Jr. Gold Roster signing will happen November 23, 24 or 25th, depending on D5 availability. Re-rostered Squirt signing is set for December 11th. Squirts will sign new rosters on Monday, December 8th or Tuesday, December 9th.

• Manager Report:

Squirt/U10 and above - Kari Magaard not here.

Mite/Mini-mite - Deb Lee. Managers have been picked, teams have been posted and jerseys have been handed out.

• Equipment Report:

Derek Gale was not here. Rick Mueller said there is a lot of equipment missing. If you take anything or have taken anything out of the equipment room you must notify Derek Gale. Thank you.

• Volunteer Report:

Stephanie Kohnen not here. Make sure you are signing up for your volunteer hours on line.

• Metro Report:

We are still in need of a Metro rep.

• Hockey Operations Report:

Coaches clinic went well. Differentiate practices to make sure that all skaters are focused on. Also, each team will choose one dryland coach and one goaltender coach to attend a clinic put on by Jim Rooney and Ed Roethke to cover material pertinent to each position.

Jim stepped down as skills clinician. Skills clinics on Monday nights will turn into team practices. The board feels the loss of this position is very unfortunate.

Overall, tryouts went smoothly. All teams except squirt A have been picked.

Ed Roethke put together a vision for the future of the girls' program. He outlines past, current and future objectives of the program.

All mites have been dotted and teams picked.

The only person who asked to be paid for the fall clinic was Larry Hendrickson. All other coaches donated their time. HOC is requesting that the amount not paid out to coaches, approx \$3,500, be used to upgrade the dryland equipment. Bob Driver will create a list of items needed.



November Board Meeting



Sponsor Report:

Banners are done. Inserts went out in chamber newsletter.

• Old Business:

The criminal investigation into the theft from BYHA over the past couple of years has taken longer than previously thought but it is ongoing. Criminal charges are expected to be filed before the year's end. We have submitted a claim with our insurance company for the loss as well. It will be several months before we have a final answer to how much money we will be able to recover from the insurance company, the banks, and from court ordered restitution. Rest assured we will aggressively pursue all avenues to recover as much as we possibly can for all BYHA members. Anyone who believes they may have relevant information about this case is encouraged to call Det. Barrett Chrissis with the Buffalo Police Department at 628-5976.

New Business:

Joel Barzee from Sports Diamond was here to present fundraising opportunity – 10% of sales would come back to BYHA. They send out 3 emails per 12 months. Bob made a motion to email 3 times a year to set up program, Donnie 2nd, motion passed unanimously.

Buffalo Days – Kim Wahl here on their behalf to suggest if BYHA would like to do a pancake breakfast and/or sell buttons. We are interested but do not need any decision right now.

Bill Alexander made a proposal to have exclusive rights to sell apparrel for BYHA. One tournament already has a t-shirt vendor commitment, Bill can have the other tournaments.

Mites ice fees – 2 members wanted to pull out and be refunded. Registration fees are not refundable.

Marketing Report:

Nothing.

District 5 Report:

The Secretary's report it is on the web.

Treasurer's report shows a total account balance of \$17,124.44. The balance is low right now due to early payments of referee fees and bills related to the start up of the season. A reminder to coaches and parents about the MN Hockey zero tolerance policy. Please keep your emotions and language in check at games and practices.

Buffalo has been fined \$300 for a late drop fee since we did not notify the district within the time line that we would not have a Bantam C team. Attempts to have the fine waived were rejected. BYHA owes D-5 \$1,100.00 for the 11 traveling teams as a team fee. BYHA owes D-5 \$5,768.00 for referee fees. MN Hockey would like copies of all future member associations tax returns. This is to have some over sight and make sure that we are all playing by the rules. Reminder that the winning team in league play sends in the score sheets to D-5. Coaches are reminded to get their CEP updated and activated before December 31st or you will be reclassified as a "former coach". D-5 is offering a \$400 grant to any association who wishes to purchase a Rink Writer program for score keeping. The cost is around \$600-\$725 for the program and you must have a computer dedicated to it as well. Reminder that the weather policy is in the hand book. Everyone is encouraged to review it before the season.
