REFUND POLICY

This refund policy explains the situations whereby a player and his/her parents may apply for a refund from the Brainerd Amateur Hockey Association.

- ❖ The fee of \$50.00 paid to USA Hockey and MN Hockey is non-refundable. This fee will be retained from the player fee to cover the player insurance cost already paid by Brainerd Amateur Hockey Association or paid directly to USA Hockey with USA Hockey Registration on-line.
- ❖ Any late fees paid are non refundable

Refunds may be granted up to December 1st of the current season. The amount refunded will be less the USA/MN Hockey fees and any late fees paid. Also 25% of your registration fee will be deducted for participation up to December 1st.

Refunds after December 1, of the current membership year, will be given in only in the following situations:

1. The player, from either the in-house or traveling program is injured and/or has a medical condition that will not permit his continued participation in the program. Written verification by the attending physician is required.
2. The family members and the player, from either the in-house or traveling program, will be moving to another community before the completion of the season. A written request must be sent by the parent.

Refunds after December 1st will pro-rated by the date of the refund request by the Board of Directors.

All refund requests must be submitted in writing to the Treasurer and the request will be reviewed by the President and Treasurer for approval. The request can be sent to BAHA, P.O. Box 38, Brainerd, MN 56401.
