Gambling Report:

• Registration Report:

Report from Monica Kunkel. New MN Hockey participation rules requires that all traveling skaters registering in Buffalo must attend a school within our geographic boundaries (public or private). Players who attend a school outside of our boundaries, but skated with BYHA last year may make a one-time decision to remain with BYHA for the remainder of their youth career. Players electing to do so will be required to fill out an additional form, available at in-person registration or on the D5 website. Mite and younger may choose to skate with the association of school attendance or parent/guardian residence. Waivers will be required for traveling players who neither reside in nor attend school in the BYHA boundaries.

Online registration is open through August 29th for returning and new players. New players ONLY will have an opportunity to register on September 26th. Jr. Gold players may register any time through November 23rd. Families with unpaid balances from 2008-09 or before will be considered inactive until balances are paid infull.

Registration numbers to date: Mini-mites-19; Mites-23; Squirts-10; 10U-2; Peewee-3; 12U-2; Bantam-7; 14U-2; Jr. Gold-1; Inactive-5. Total: 73

\$50 late fee applies to returning players after noon on August 29th. All documents, payments and deposit checks must be submitted to be considered registered. Late fee for traveling players increases to \$100 after September 26th and \$200 after November 7th. Players who cannot make in-person registration dates may contact the registrar for mail-in registration. All

documents must still be received by August 29th to avoid late registration fees.

Final team declarations are due to D5 by September 30th.

Roster signing for Peewee, 12U, Bantam, and 14U will be November 7th. Squirt, 10U and Jr. Gold rosters will be signed by appointment prior to first tournament or first league game.

Persons wishing to coach must submit USA/MN Hockey confirmation page, MN Hockey screening form and D5 Coaching Ethics and a copy of coaching card prior to being rostered. Those wishing to be a team manager must submit a screening form prior to team assignment.

Steve moved to spend \$400 on registration. Mike 2nd. Motion passed unanimously.

• Equipment Report:

Derek Gale – we will need to buy mini mite and mite jerseys, socks will need to be ordered, have enough pucks. 1st aid kits are gone, no water bottles. Should be able to get through one more year of goalie equipment.

Sponsor Report:

Report from Bob Furneisen. Donnie and Bob met with the city to discuss how we can market in the arena.

Marketing Report:

Mailer – we should do this this year. We did not do last year. Leslie motioned to approve \$650 for a mailer to be sent out to about 1,000 families. Donnie 2nd. Motion passed unanimously. Schools may not handout flyers anymore.

District 5 Report:

Report from Steve Pearson - The Secretary report for the April meeting was accepted. Treasurer's report shows a total account balance of \$31,113.31. The yearly budget is 20K.

DATES TO REMEMBER: D-5 meetings are the first Wednesday of each month starting at 7:30 P.M. Meetings are held at Daniel's Family Restaurant in Cokato. Ice scheduling meeting will be Sept. 30 at 6:30 P.M. in Cokato. Roster signing day is Nov. 7th 8:00-noon in Cokato.

D-5's MN Hockey representative Doug Kephart outlined the rules for mites and mini mites. The rules include but are not limited to the following: Mites are ages 7-8 and mini mites are under 7 years old. D-5 mite teams are not allowed to play other teams outside the district. Exceptions must be approved by Kephart. Mini mites can only play cross ice in house games. Games may begin after January 20th of each season. Mites can play in a maximum of 12 games/scrimmages regardless of how where or when they play. A maximum of 4 games can be played with other associations. Mites can play in 1 jamboree per season. Mites can play a maximum of 5 in house games. No "super mite" teams that travel around will be allowed. 2 jamobrees will be offered in the district each season on different dates so that there is a choice.

Jeff Carlen is the D-5 scheduling coordinator.

There was much discussion about the format of games being played in D-5. Travel costs are among the concerns that were raised. There were 3 options put on the table to address the D-5 scheduling issues. First, keep things as they are. Second, play each other only 1 time per season, alternate home teams each year. Third, format and east/west arrangement, playing teams closer to you. After discussion and the

Vote, the decision was to leave things the way they are.

D-5 will try to use a double elimination format this year for playoffs.

Optional year end squirt tournament was discussed. This would include squirt A, B, C, and 10U. Dates would be March 19-21, 2010. Costs would be assessed to the teams that play. Tournament games would count toward maximum allowable games for each team. BYHA must commit by January , 2010 if we want to participate. If we drop out after that date there is a \$300 fine for each team that drops out.

BYHA must give D-5 a copy of our tax return before roster signing.

MAML will host peewee B regional tournament in March.

The new D-5 handbook will be on the web site next week.

Mites can register where they live or where they go to school, they can choose.

Squirts and above must register to play where they go to school OR, for one time only, they can register where they live and play there during their whole "career".

New rule changes are on the web site.

• Old Business:

Criminal case is still pending. Buffalo PD says interviews are happening now.

New Business:

Mike Mooney came to present USA Hockey rule changes. Changes are on the website. Some highlights are changes to stick blade, changes to major and match penalties. New officials training sessions going on this fall. There are about 200 officials in D5. D5 retains about 90% from level 1 to 2.

Bob Ehrsman discussed fee structure and clinics.

Donnie Thompson has contacted Hanover Athletic Association to partner in having an outdoor hocky day at Hanover.

Motion to adjourn, 2nd. Meeting adjourned at 10:05.
