Proposed Regulation change: (registration)

Motion by Lee, seconded by Gieske and unanimously approved to revise MAHA Youth Rules and Regulation (12) f. and present to MAHA; delete all referees must attend a Referees Clinic each season and insert all 1st, 2nd and 3rd year officials must attend a mandatory clinic, thereafter officials must attend a AHAUS mandatory clinic when rules have been changed.

Proposed Regulation change: (clinics)

Discussed Purpose and Job Description of the Supervisor of Officials. Will be discussed at more detail in the future. (next fall meeting)

Information (S.O.O. Purpose and Job Description)

MHOA fees; what they are going to be used for? printing, films, on ice clinics, mailing, etc.

Information (fees)

Games being done by non-registered officials, mostly in the northern part of the state. Sometimes it can not be helped, but District Director and Supervisor of Officials should and must be notified. ALL GAMES MUST BE OFFICIATED BY REGISTERED AHAUS OFFICIALS.

Information (not using registered officials)

Lee; meaning of "registered": when applicant passes test, applicant will be sent the following: card, crest and referee's manual. At this time the applicant is officially registered.

Information (meaning of being Registered)

Supervisor of Officials: when covering at large area, should get others as his/her assistant(s) to help in this type of problem.

Information (to much area to cover)

Disciplinary procedures for officials discussed and majority approved to table until next fall meeting.

Information (official disciplinary procedures)

Discussion of having districts pay for mileage, phone calls and other expenses incurred by S.O.O. Unanimously approved to ask district if they will pay for expenses and if not send them to MHOA for reimbursement.

Information (payment for expenses; S.O.O.)

Have MAHA supply Supervisor of Officials with pass cards for MAHA sanctioned games for the 1984-1985 season.
