The South Supervisors submitted a list of rule changes at the Spring Meeting. President Leslie asked for discussion and a vote on each of the rule changes.

Major Penalty + Game Misconduct (change Game Misconduct to a Game Disqualification). Player would not miss an additional game.

Mouthguard rule should apply to all players, not just Defeated ... PeeWees and above.

Accepted ... Checking - player would not be eligible to be body checked after giving up possession of the puck.

Accepted ... Mouthguard must be secured to the face mask and must be an opaque color so as to be easily identified.

President Leslie directed "Skip" Trumble to write these rule change proposals in a format suitable for submission to USA Hockey.

Brad Trumble distributed a new revision of the MHOA Officials Report form and a new revision of the Officials Rating Form. President Leslie and the Supervisors thanked Brad for a good job of revising the forms.

"Skip" Trumble distributed an Officials Seminar Agenda that allows a Basic and an Intermediate Seminar to be held at the same time and at the same location.

USA Hockey Report:

Dick Haney reported that a USA Hockey District Seminar will be held in Fargo, ND, in the fall of 1991. MinnKota District referees will have the opportunity to attend (first come - first served) and the seminar will be limited to fifty (50) participants.

Dick reported that there are 1,413 officials registered in the

MinnKota District.

The National Bantam A Tournament will be held in Moorhead in April The selection of officials to work the tournament will be similar to the 1990 Tournament at East Grand Forks. The referees will be USA Hockey Level 4 and the linesmen will be Level 3 or Level 4.

A handout describing the new icing procedure was distributed. lead man will now whistle the play stopped when the puck crosses the

goal line extended.

Dick announced, that by popular demand, additional referee crests will be available at \$5.00 each to registered officials.

There being no further business, Dean Nybakke, seconded by "Skip" Trumble, moved to adjourn.

The motion passed unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 5:24 p.m.
