JUNIOR GOLD REPORT

- 1. Jr Gold A, B and U16 season's are completed.
- 2. Jr Gold A team finished the season 4-18-2 in league play and did not progress to the Regional Playoffs. They finished 8-6 in tournament play with a couple of third place finishes. The Jr Gold A team was challenged with low numbers, numerous conflicts with players work schedules, a light talent pool because of no cuts from either high school team, and difficulty staying out of the penalty box. Even with a challenging year in league play, the team had a great time and there was no shortage of ice time for the boys. My thanks go out to my coaching staff (Ryan Bjurstrom, Tom Miller) and our manager Michelle Wolf...they all did a great job this year.

- 3. Jr Gold B team finished 2-22 in league play and did not advance to the Regional Playoffs. They finished well in tournament play with a 2nd place finish in the Albert lea tournament. The Jr Gold B team was also challenged with low numbers, work conflicts and a light talent pool. Even with their challenges the team had a very fun year and the players got to play a ton of hockey. My thanks go out to John Wilmes, his coaching staff, and Sally Stanek (team manager)...they did a great job with the team this year.
- 4. Jr Gold U16 team finished the season with a 8-10-6 and advanced to the Regional play downs, where they lost to their final game and did not advance to state. They also played well in Tournament play winning the Schwan's Cup over New years. The U16 team had a very nice season and came within one game of making it to the State Tournament. Al Kaufmann, his coaching staff and team manger did a great job this year.
- 5. The Jr Gold A team held Sr night on Feb 25th, honoring 12 seniors on the team. We also held a memorial for Lou Maneli who passed away in October. Lou was a huge supporter of Jr Gold and OMGHA hockey. A plaque was presented to his wife Michelle.

- 8. Each team is having an end of the season banquet to celebrate the season. Jersey's will be collected and turned in to the equipment shed.
- 9. This is my final Jr Gold Report...I want to thank everyone who has supported Jr Gold Hockey during my 7 year tenure. Even though I'm done with my official capacity as Jr Gold Director, I am willing to offer support to next year's Jr Gold Director to allow for a smooth transition.
