RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR USE OF CIVIC CENTER

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker room assignments will be provided by the arena staff to accommodate orderly usage. Please vacate locker room as soon as possible to allow for the next team to use it. TEAMS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO LEAVE A CLEAN AND USABLE LOCKER ROOM. Locker room privileges may be denied to teams who misuse, damage, or leave the locker room disorderly. Supervision by a coach or parent is strongly suggested.

HOCKEY RINK

NO ONE ON THE ICE UNTIL ZAMBONI GATE IS CLOSED! Nobody is permitted on the ice while the zamboni is in operation. Teams coaches and groups are expected to have vacated the ice when their time is up.

PLAYERS BOX/PENALTY BOX/SCOREBOARD

No one under the age of 18 will be allowed inside the penalty and scoreboard boxes without permission from Arena Staff. No one under the age of 18 is allowed in the penalty and players boxes without a helmet.

THIS FACILITY IS TOBACCO FREE

NO SMOKING OR TOBACCO CHEWING IS ALLOWED IN ANY PART OF THIS FACILITY! Smoking is permitted only outside of the building.

SPITTING

ABSOLUTELY NO SPITTING IS ALLOWED ANYWHERE WITHIN THIS FACILITY!

BENSON CIVIC CENTER DISIPLINARY ACTION PROGRAM

The Benson Civic Center Disciplinary Action Program is for any person(s) disobeying any of the Arena's rules and regulations.

Listing of Rules and Regulations:

- 1. No use of sticks or pucks *except* on the ice and/or near the shooting tarp.
- 2. No spitting anywhere in the building.
- 3. No obscene language.
- 4. No acts of vandalism.
- 5. No food or beverages, other than water, on ice or in the player's boxes.
- 6. No use of tobacco products in the facility.
- 7. Nobody under the age of 18 should be in penalty box, score table, or any other restricted areas without permission.
- 8. Nobody should be on the ice during resurfacing or while the zamboni gates are open.
- 9. Teams and players must clean up after themselves on the bench and in the locker rooms after each event.

The disciplinary action for anyone found disobeying these rules would be left of to the discretion of the rink attendant and/or the Benson Youth Hockey Board. Any one of the following consequences will be applied:

- 1. Warning.
- 2. Parent(s) contacted.
- 3. Removal from building for a specified length of time, depending on the infraction.
- 4. Restriction from participating in games.
- 5. Restriction from participating in any Benson Youth Hockey Program.
