### GAMBLING REPORT

Request for expense coverage at \$26,805 for Dec expenses. Motion approved.

Julie Prince passed out the years end report from Larson Allen reporting that we are in good standing. She also provided years end financial statements (page 2 of packet) that we filed with the state. We are currently at a four star rating which is very good. The minimum level is three.

A Business Snapshot Report was provided. This report is a two year gross and net receipt comparison. Our gross receipts are up nearly \$30,000 from this time last year with our net receipts up nearly \$7,000.

A request was made to adjust the November expenses from \$25,805 to \$33,705 incurred through additional supplies. Request was approved.

Julie would like to form a gambling committee to meet as needed to discuss new ideas and gambling issues.

Joe Prince brought up the point of having a policy regarding gambling employee pay adjustments. Will need to discuss. Julie is putting together a performance manual procedure for employee reviews.

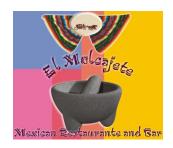
