Centennial Lakes Little League Duties and Responsibilities

The following is a brief description of the duties and responsibilities that coincide with a position held in the Centennial Lakes Little League. This list is not intended to be all encompassing and further information should be requested if questions arise.

Mandatory (to be considered for a coach)

- Must Attend *Coaches Meetings & Clinics*
- Must Attend Park Cleanup day
- Must Attend Winter Workouts
- Pass Background Check as required by National Little League regulations.

(appropriate to age group applying to coach)

Workouts will be in the Centennial Lakes Little League Gym

Duties

- Hold a pre-season team and parent meeting prior to or at first practice.
- Plan and hold <u>a minimum of one</u> organized practice per week (the League office has a library of resources for practice drills).
- Be knowledgeable of the rules of the game and be able to interpret them correctly. Follow these rules at all times in order for players to learn respect for coaches, officials, and rules of the game.
- Set a positive example for your team.
- Assist with the distribution and, when applicable, collection of uniforms.
- Assist with preparation and operation of tournaments and other special events.
- Be responsible for all team equipment and return it to the league rep no later than two weeks after league play is completed.
- Communicate with and assist team parent when needed.
- Communicate with league rep for any information or assistance needed to coach your team.
- Communicate with equipment manager to make sure equipment is maintained in a safe and useable condition.
