For a \$40 annual fee, you get more enhanced capabilities on UA. That includes access to a database of most of the college volleyball programs in the United States. There is also a "Needs List" where college coaches list what positions they are looking to recruit by High School graduation year. You can search by state or by position to see where you might be interested in playing, and who needs your skills.

Once you find colleges that interest you, you can add them to a favorites list on the website. Then, when you are going to a tournament, you can send a bulk email to all the coaches on your list to tell them you'll be there. This is a great feature to help you stay in contact with programs you like.

One of the best features of UA is that you can upload about 5 minutes of video clips, so coaches can see you play, even if they can't make it to your tournaments. You can log in at any time and add video clips or update your profile information.
