



Players Codes of Conduct Policy

The Hamel Athletic Club Board of Directors has mandated the following Code of Conduct. All players will read this Code of Conduct and acknowledge that he or she understands and agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct.

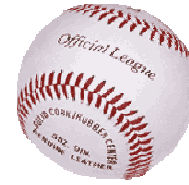
No player shall at any time:

- Push, shove, and threaten to strike or intentionally try to injury another player, coach or official.
- Throw gloves, helmets, bats, balls or any other unsportsman like action.
- Speak disrespectfully to any player, coach, official or representative of the league.
- Use profane, obscene or vulgar language at any time.
- Be guilty of using any chemical to alter the player's physical state (alcohol, drugs or tobacco).
- Leave the field of play or dugout during a game to mingling with or fraternizing with spectators during the course of a game.
- Challenge an umpire's authority. The umpires shall have the authority and discretion during a game to penalize the offender according to the infraction up to and including expulsion from the game.

Players are expected to:

- Attend all practices and games. Absences are expected, however it is the players duty to notify the coach of an absence in advance of a practice or game.
- Wear the appropriate clothing and bring all appropriate equipment to each practice or game.
 - Game uniform -
 - Jerseys - tucked in to pants
 - Gray Pants
 - Royal Belt
 - Royal Socks
 - Hamel Baseball Cap
 - Batting Helmet
 - Jerseys and pants washed for games
 - Jacket brought on cold nights
 - Protective cups to be worn at all practices and games (LL and above)

The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the Code of Conduct. Depending on the seriousness or frequency, the board may assess additional disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league.



Coaches Code of Conduct Policy

The Hamel Athletic Club Board of Directors has mandated the following Code of Conduct. All board members, coordinators, coaches and team representatives will read this Code of Conduct and acknowledge that he or she understands and agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct.

No board member, coordinator, coach or team representative shall at any time:

- Lay a hand upon, push, shove or threaten to strike a player or official
- Be guilty of heaping personal verbal or physical abuse on any official for any real or imaginary belief of a wrong decision or judgment.
- Be guilty of an objectionable demonstration of dissent at an official's decision by throwing gloves, helmets, bats, balls or any other forceful unsportsman-like action.
- Be guilty of using rough tactics in the play of a game against the body of another player.
- Be guilty of a physical attack upon any board member, official manager, coach, player or spectator.
- Be guilty of the use of profane, obscene or vulgar language at any time.
- Appear on the field of play, stands or anywhere in the complex while in an intoxicated state.
- Be guilty of gambling upon any play or outcome of any game with anyone at any time.
- Smoke while in the stands or on the playing field or in any dugout.
- Be guilty of publically discussing with spectators in a derogatory or abusive manner any play, decision or personal opinion on any players during the game.
- As a coach, be guilty of mingling with or fraternizing with spectators during the course of a game.
- Speak disrespectfully to any manager, coach, official or representative of the league.
- Be guilty of tampering or manipulating any league rosters, schedules, draft positions or selections, official score books, rankings, financial records or procedures.
- Challenge an umpire's authority. The umpires shall have the authority and discretion during a game to penalize the offender according to the infraction up to and including expulsion from the game.

The Board of Directors will review all infractions of the Code of Conduct. Depending on the seriousness or frequency, the board may assess additional disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the league.



Parent/Spectators Code of Conduct Policy

No spectator shall at any time:
