Letter from DHSHA President

Fans of Dublin Hockey

Welcome to the 2010 - 2011 hockey season!

On behalf of the players and coaches of Coffman, Jerome and Scioto Varsity programs and JV Green(Coffman) and JV White(Jerome) we are pleased to embark on another exciting hockey campaign. The Dublin High School Hockey Association (DHSHA) is the volunteer parent organization that in partnership with the Dublin School District supports five teams and last season over 105 players. DHSHA continues to build a rich and successful tradition here in Central Ohio. Last season our players demonstrated excellence on the ice as well as in the classroom. Fifteen of our student athletes were selected as All Capital Hockey Conference (CHC) honorees with 4 of them landing on the first team all district. Importantly, Thirty five of our student athletes earned CHC academic honors with Twenty two placing on the first team All Academic CHC team. We also continued to build our competitive reputation in Central Ohio as each of our teams demonstrated success on the ice in 2009 -2010. Dublin Coffman was the first Dublin team in our history to make it to the Ohio State Final Four. Dublin Jerome won the Blue Jackets cup and Dublin Scioto won the MLK/Ottawa Hills Invitational. Dublin Coffman and Dublin Scioto enter their 8th season(s) of Varsity competition, while Dublin Jerome enters their 6th season of Varsity play. We will continue to align our JV teams with their respective high schools to promote continuity and development. Our goal continues to be the development of JV players for our Varsity programs both as players and student athletes. DHSHA is quite pleased to have an excellent coaching staff that has been with Dublin Hockey for a number of years. We feel confident that our coaching staff is focused on fielding competitive teams as well as making our players good teammates and responsible young adults. All of the work that goes into our Dublin Hockey program is made possible by the year round efforts of the DHSHA Board and Association. 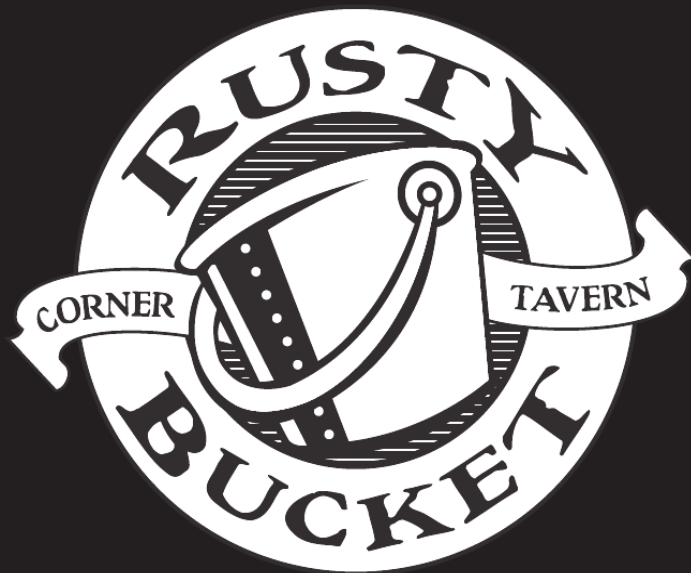

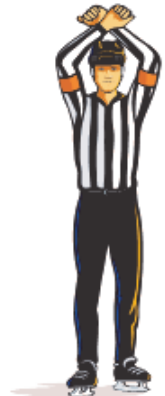

Perry Pooley
Head Coach



◀Entering his 9th consecutive season as Head Coach, Perry Pooley has amassed quite an impressive record, 189-93-23. During this time, Coach Pooley, has helped the Shamrocks to 3-CHC titles, 3 Blue Jacket Cup titles, 4- Final 8 appearances with 1 District Championship in 2010 and 1 State Final Four appearance.

Pooley is remembered as one of the all-time greatest, Ohio State University hockey players, earning All-Conference, All-American and "All Century Team" honors while playing as a Buckeye.

Pooley was the 5th leading scorer in the nation and helped OSU to their first #1 national ranking in November 1983. Coach Pooley was a 4-year letterman and an Academic All-American, earning a degree in Business with majors in both accounting and marketing and maintaining a 3.39 GPA.

In 1984, he served as OSU's captain and was voted the team's "Best Sportsman". Pooley is also remembered for playing alongside his twin brother, Paul, who is now the assistant coach at Notre Dame University, NCAA Div I.

From 1984-86, Pooley played for the Winnipeg Jets organization and also their affiliate, the Sherbrooke Canadiens, in the AHL, where they won the league championship, Calder Cup, and later in the New York Rangers farm system, the (try and find out the team name) , in the (league), in Canada.

Currently he owns and operates several business including Irrigation Solutions and Martooley Lighting. Coach Pooley and his wife Sharon, and two boys, Austin 14 and Connor 12, reside in Dublin.

▶ **Coach Scott Adamick** begins his 9th year as Assistant Coach of the Rocks. Adamick who played high school hockey at Newington, Connecticut, leads a 24/7 hockey life. Adamick currently serves as an off-ice official for the National Hockey League Columbus Blue Jackets. His past experience includes working for the Chiller LLC, as assistant hockey director. Scott also served as a director for the Chiller Adult Hockey League (CAHL) which is the 3rd largest adult hockey league in the country before leaving to pursue other opportunities. Adamick a defenseman in his playing days, has coached at all levels of youth hockey (mites-bantam) and at the collegiate level, where he served on the staff of the Bowling Green State University Women's team. Adamick a Hartford, Connecticut native, graduated from Bowling Green in 1997 with a degree in telecommunications.

◀ **Coach Matt Berner** hails from Fredericton, New Brunswick, Canada, and grew up playing travel and high school hockey in Hamburg, New York. He was a part of a New York State Championship team that went on to place fourth in the Nationals. He played two years of collegiate hockey at SUNY Potsdam, in upstate New York and two years of collegiate hockey at Wheaton College, in Illinois. Coach Berner has instructed hockey schools in Canada and the United States. Coach Berner has been an instructor on the staff of the Blue Jackets Hockey School as well as the Junior Jackets Hockey Program since 2000. Coach Berner is in his second year working with the Coffman Rocks Hockey Team. Coach Berner teaches 8th grade Social Studies at Sells Middle School. Coach Berner, his wife, Jordan their two sons and 6 month old Olivia reside in Powell.

Head Coach
Pat Murphy

◀ **Head Coach Murphy** grew up in upstate New York where he played U.S. Junior "A" hockey for the Buffalo Junior Sabres on his way to Hamilton College in Clinton, New York, where he earned degrees in Economics and Government. While at Hamilton College, "Murph" was an all American candidate while playing for their division III hockey team. He was their leading scorer in 1991 and earned Eastern College Athletic Conference All Star honors, their MVP, and earned The Hamilton College "Coaches Award," and the school's "Gelas Award" for sportsmanship, leadership and strength of character. He played his professional hockey in Oslo, Norway for Hasle Loren in their Elite Series and started coaching while in Norway with Pee Wees. His coaching resume continued with young players following his return to New York where he was the assistant coach for the New York State Amateur Hockey Association select 16 team, Head Coach of The New York City Cyclones, as well as the head coach of the New York City Girls Empire State Team.. He has also had extensive experience managing youth leagues and adult leagues as the Director of Hockey at the Chelsea Piers in New York City. Having served as the Head Coach of the Dublin JV team, he was named as the first Head Coach of the Dublin Jerome High School Varsity Ice Hockey Team for its inaugural 2004-2005 season. Coach Murphy is a faculty member at Dublin Jerome High School where he teaches psychology and United States government. He lives in Dublin with his wife Bridget, and their two children, Maggie and Connor.

◀ **Coach Mayfield** grew up in Buffalo, NY where he attended Canisius High School and later went on to attend Canisius College. While at Canisius he earned his Bachelor's Degree in Marketing. Coach Mayfield's athletic career is rooted in baseball. He played amateur baseball for numerous teams and leagues including American Legion, Triple ABA and Triple A Mundy. While playing his amateur baseball he earned the distinction as one of the youngest players to play in an American Legion baseball game in New York State at the age of fourteen. He has also earned MVP, Coach's Awards, Sportsmanship Awards and multiple All-Star selections throughout his baseball career. He pursued his career which took him to professional tryouts for the Tampa Bay Devil Rays and New York Mets organizations. He has ten years of coaching experience at multiple levels ranging from youth through college level baseball. Coach Mayfield also has extensive experience managing youth and amateur leagues while serving as the League Coordinator for District 8 and New York State American Legion Baseball for three years. He has also served as the Assistant to the Chairman for New York State American Legion Baseball for four years. Growing up in Buffalo and being raised in a family of accomplished hockey players and referees, Coach Mayfield made his transition from baseball to hockey in 2004 when he moved to Columbus to work for the Columbus Blue Jackets. He has instructed both youth and adult players while at The Chiller and is in his second season as Assistant Coach of the Dublin Jerome Celtics Varsity Hockey team. Coach Mayfield currently resides in Grandview Heights with his wife Rachel and two children, Nicholas and Reece.

▶ **Coach Zesiger** grew up in Westerville, Ohio where he attended Walnut Springs Middle School and Westerville North High School. Sports were a huge part of Coach Z's childhood playing everything from baseball, soccer, football, golf, track and field, and ice hockey. Once in high school golf and hockey were his main focus. He received a "Coaches award" in golf his senior year helping get North to its 3rd place finish in the State. He has also received a "Playmaker Award" from his CAHA ice hockey team for unselfish play and most assists.

After high school, Coach Z went on and attended college at The University of Kentucky graduating with a degree in Biology. After college he lived abroad in Central America and the Bahamas conducting environmental science research with Duke University and teaching at a marine science research facility. In 2006, Coach Z returned back home to Westerville to get his education degree and begin teaching. He attended Capital University and received his education degree in 2009.
