Meeting Minutes April 6, 2011

Meeting called to order by President Tim Hanson at 7:15 p.m. following the annual year end dinner that started at 6:00 p.m.

Attendance: All of the District 5 teams were in attendance.

Secretary's Report: The minutes from the March 2, 2011 meeting were previously prepared and posted on the website. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Buffalo. Seconded by STMA. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: A written report as to the District finances was provided (See attached). Coaching refunds to Associations have not yet been paid because the District first needs to wait until it receives money from the associations for playoffs. Associations need to pay playoff fees.

Encouraged others to get involved and see how committed the current board is and compared what he thought of the board when he was President of his association...and now on the other side of the table, how much respect he has for Doug Kephart and the board. President Hanson also thanked Robert for his dedication.

4. USAH Body Checking Rule Proposal.

- a. Doug has been appointed to committee for MN Hockey developing a position. One option, lobby for point of emphasis vs. rule change.
- b. The 6 other largest districts in the Nation (besides MN Hockey) are developing their positions as well, but haven't given it as much thought to date as MN Hockey.
- c. Options rather than rule change include but not limited: (1) coaches go to checking clinic, (2) point of emphasis training, and (3) injury tracting forms.

Despite card sticker, everyone will need new clinic for 2011-2012 season if they desire to coach. Check the website for information and changes.
