- **Reputation of Excellence:** Our program is **well known** by tournament directors and college coaches. Because Tomahawks has an excellent track record and is known for having quality players, NH Tomahawks has a following of coaches which means **extra attention for our players** and optimal recruiting opportunities at tournaments.
- Quality Players We are fortunate to attract players from all over New Hampshire and even border states of MA, ME & VT. This means we have an outstanding talent pool from which to select our teams. When you make a Tomahawk team, you play with the best. In the last 5 years, 34 out of the 37 New Hampshire All Americans were NH Tomahawk players!
