Registration Instructions for 2011-2012 season

Registration day at Graham 3 September 13th & 14th 2011, 6:00-8:00 p.m.

Late registration in Graham Lobby September 21st 2011, 6:30-7:30 p.m.

ALL REGISTRATIONS MUST BE DONE ONLINE

RYHA will no longer be using paper registration forms

Online registration is currently open

If your player falls in one of the following groups:

- Bantams (ages 13,14)
- Peewee (ages 11,12)
- Squirt (ages 9,10)
- Girls (10U, 12U, 14U) (ages 9-14)
- Girls City league (ages 7-14) (NOT Mites)
- Junior Gold (ages 15 -18) No Team in Rochester for 2011-12. If interested in playing Junior Gold there will be a team in Albert Lea.

Register for USA Hockey (<u>www.usahockey.com</u>) **first** and then RYHA (<u>www.ryha.net</u>) **second**.

On Registration day bring the following to Graham 3:

- Printed copy of USA Hockey barcode.
- A complete printed copy of your email receipt from Rochester MN Youth Hockey. This email will contain all your players' information and your receipt showing whether you have paid online or remain unpaid.

If your player falls in one of the following groups:

- Rookies (ages 3,4)
- Termites (ages 5,6)
- Supermites (ages 7,8)
- Supermites trying out for Squirts (age 8)
- Supermites girls trying out for Girls 10U or above Register for RYHA (<u>www.ryha.net</u>) **ONLY.** You do not need to register for USA Hockey at this time.

NOTE: If your **supermite**, boy or girl, tries out for and makes a **squirt** or **girls** team you will need to register your player with USA Hockey before he or she can be placed on a team roster.

On Registration day bring the following to Graham 3:

 A complete printed copy of your email receipt from Rochester MN Youth Hockey. This email will contain all your players' information and your receipt showing whether you have paid online or remain unpaid.

To register with RYHA, click on the registration link of the RYHA website. If you were required to register with USA Hockey, you will need your USA member number. After entering all the required information on the registration form, you will have the option to use your credit card and pay registration fees online.

You must come to Registration day at Graham 3 even if you paid online. Signs will direct you to the appropriate payment tables.

You must have a "PAID" stamp on your printed email receipt before visiting the coaches' tables for tryout information or they will not accept your entry forms.

A convenience fee will be assessed for using a credit card for payment. This fee is to cover the costs RYHA is charged when you use your credit card. See *fees* page on website.

2011-2012 RYHA Girls Program

The girl's hockey committee and coaches met over the summer to set a direction for this upcoming season. There is no perfect plan that fits everyone's situation but we have decided to expand the traveling component of girl's hockey. We would like to transition the Girls City League (GCL) into a level for our younger players and for those that are new to hockey. The plan for the 2011-2012 season is:

14UA - one team, probably will play in District 8

14UB - one team, probably will play in District 6

12UA - one team, probably will play in District 8

12UB - two teams with smaller rosters, will play in District 9

10UA - one team, probably will play in District 8

10UB - two teams with smaller rosters, probably will play in District 9

GCL - 3-4 teams with smaller rosters will play in Rochester

The reason we don't know for certain which District our travel teams will participate in is that it is all controlled by the number of teams. The other associations within our District (9) do not typically have the number of players that Rochester has. When I attend the Minnesota Hockey meeting in October the representatives of each District compare team numbers and try to form leagues that have an adequate number of teams. Some Districts have too few to have a viable league of their own and others have so many teams that they don't want to accept additional teams from another District. If our registration numbers do not support our plan then of course we will modify the number of teams.

Do you have friends that are interested in trying hockey? The Fall Hockey School has a group dedicated to them. Your friends can try hockey out to see if they are really interested. I have equipment in my garage that is dedicated to getting new players started.
