* **SPECIAL NOTICE:** The BHA board will be enforcing a late registration penalty as discussed at the annual mtg of \$25.00 this year if you have not paid your registration in full by September 30th. You will not be allowed to take the ice for the 2011-2012 season until you have submitted registration payment in full. Please keep in mind there is also financial assistance through the **Benson Amateur Sports Association** which is strictly confidential.

* We are also enforcing the work hrs policy which states that you will be invoiced \$20.00 per hr at the end of the year for the hours that were not worked and if left unpaid your child will not be able to participate in the following season until paid in full. These hrs will be tracked monthly and posted and there will also be plenty of option's available to work these hrs off throughout the season.

There will also be a learn to skate opportunity for anyone interested on Saturday November 5th from 1:00-4:00.
