A. Administrative & Financial Matters

1. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

2. President's Report

- **a.** Age group Reps are still needed for the following: Bantams, PeeWee's, 12U, and Mite 1's.

D. BCA

1. BCA Board Meeting

- **a.** BCA Board came to the Board Meeting to present the Building Capital Improvements. The BCA board has identified a limited scope of work to be completed at the BCA this late summer.
- **b.** There will be 3 main work objectives for the rink:
 - (1) Complete all work in the BYHA locker rooms including rubber flooring, benches, shelving, hooks, etc.
 - (2) Complete minor structural additions and revisions to the mezzanine and complete the mezzanine floor topping. The mezzanine will NOT be able to be occupied after this work, but it is significant progress.
 - (3) Complete the drywall at the east mezzanine edge. The wall is required to allow advertising signage to be installed on the east end of the arena.
- c. Money for this project will come from the following sources: PBIHT Contribution of \$10,000, Capital Improvements Budget of \$25,000, Donation from a private source \$10,000, business donation \$4,000. The amount that needs to be loaned out is approximately \$186,000. This money will be paid back using the Marketing campaign and advertising that takes place at the Bemidji Community Arena.
- **d.** This project will be completed before October Hockey begins. Motion made by Jana N. to approve the BCA Building Capital Improvement plan as presented. Second by John M. The vote passed unanimously.
