 officials, program coordinators, coaches, or teams. Public criticism of officials,
 players, program coordinators, or coaches is unethical.
- 2. I will treat all players, coaches, officials, event staff, and fans with respect regardless of race, gender, creed or ability.
- 3. I will not use profanity.
- 4. I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, and contest administrators at every game.
- 5. I will respect the volunteers that are assisting with practice or youth basketball events.
- 6. I will shake hands with the opposing team and coaches after a game.
- 7. I will place the emotional and physical well being of others ahead of my personal desire to win.
- 8. I will provide a sports environment for my team that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all youth basketball events.
- 9. I will do my very best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.
- 10. I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
- 11. I will remember that I am a youth coach, and that the game is for the children and not the adults.
- 12. I will not schedule a scrimmage or practice with a non-BLYBA team without the Board of Directors' approval.
- 13. I will respect and adhere to the policies and procedures of the Big Lake Youth Basketball Association (BLYBA).
- 14. I understand the BLYBA Board of Directors has the right to remove any coach whose actions are detrimental to the team and/or the Association.
