Cross-Ice Open Hockey Rules

1. All participants must pay at the concession stand prior to skating.
2. Absolutely **NO** hockey sticks will be allowed on the open skate surface (outside the barriers). You cannot stake through the open skate ice surface with your stick. You must walk around on the mats to the north entry door to enter the open hockey playing surface.
3. All players are skating at their own risk.
4. All players must wear gloves or mittens. Helmets are highly recommended, though not required.
5. No contact or rough play will be allowed. If altercations occur, the offenders will be removed from ice and asked to leave immediately. The offenders will not be allowed to participate in open hockey for the rest of the season.
6. Everyone is allowed play regardless of ability. Older skaters should help younger skaters develop their skills.
7. No pucks will be allowed on the ice surface. All play must be conducted using a tennis ball.
8. Participants should divide teams evenly.
9. No more than 12 skaters are allowed on the ice surface while cross-ice games are in progress. Players must rotate in or out with the other players waiting on a very regular basis.
10. Players must follow directions of arena staff.
11. Report any dangerous situations or behavior to arena staff immediately.
12. NO REFUNDS will be issued.
13. No (concrete) floor hockey is allowed.
