MSHSL proposed rule changes for immediate experimental status. Proposed changes are indicated in RED in the text boxes. This language was approved by the NFHS Rules Review Committee as an experiment in the state of Minnesota.

SECTION 4: BOARDING

ART. 1...No player shall check, cross-check, elbow, charge or trip an opponent in such a manner that causes the opponent to be throw violently into the boards.

PENALTY: MINOR. If flagrant, MAJOR.

ART. 2... If the check causes the player to crash headfirst into the boards, a MAJOR or GAME **DISQUALIFICATION** penalty must be assessed.

PENALTY: MAJOR. If flagrant, MAJOR.

ART. 2...If the check causes the player to crash headfirst into the boards, a MAJOR or GAME **DISQUALIFICATION** penalty must be assessed.

SECTION 7 CHECKING FROM BEHIND

No player shall body-check an opponent from behind (checking from behind).

PENALTY: MINOR AND MISCONDUCT. If the check from behind is flagrant or causes the player to crash headfirst into the boards or goal frame, a GAME DISQUALIFICATION penalty shall be assessed.

PENALTY: MAJOR AND MISCONDUCT. If the check from behind is flagrant or causes the player to crash headfirst into the boards or goal frame, a GAME DISQUALIFICATION penalty shall be assessed.

SECTION 8 CONTACT TO THE HEAD

No player shall make contact with an opposing player's head or neck in any manner. PENALTY: MINOR or MAJOR or DISQUALIFICATION.

PENALTY: MAJOR or DISQULIFICATION.
