SPRINGFIELD YOUTH CLUB HOUSE SOCCER TEAM SPORTSMANSHIP LIAISON (TSL) FORM

The spectator sidelines at SYC House Soccer League games need to be managed by a *responsible* party **other than a team coach.** Each team will select a Team Sportsmanship Liaison (TSL) and an Alternate TSL. The selected TSL, or the Alternate TSL, must be present at all team games and will have the following responsibilities:

- ❖ Prior to each game, the TSL will identify themselves to each other and to the referee.
- ❖ Prior to each game, the TSL should discuss with the referee and coaches what role the TSL will take in the event the sidelines begin to negatively impact the match or the referee's ability to do his/her job.
- Ensure the team spectators/parents observe the spectator line.
- ❖ Be the "cooler head" should sideline behavior become extreme.
- ❖ Be the first point of contact should the referee feel he/she needs help due to inappropriate sideline behavior.
- ❖ In the event that an incident does occur which requires the attention of the League Director and/or SYC, the TSL for each team will provide a written and signed account of the incident using the Field Marshall Form found in the Field Box and provide such further information as is requested by the League Director.
