

## SECTION 1:

- 1. All personnel of Minnesota Hockey and its affiliates are subject to this screening standard.
- 2. See MN Hockey Handbook, Sexual and Physical Abuse Screening for additional information.
- 3. The intent of these rules is to reduce the risk of a MN Hockey player becoming the victim of sexual or physical abuse.
- 4. Pursuant to the Minnesota Hockey Screening Policy, all association coaches, referees, association board members and officers of MN Hockey are required to complete the MN Hockey Screening Form (online or paper copy).
  - a. Minor officials (i.e. timekeeper, scorekeeper, penalty box) do not have to complete the MN Hockey Screening Form.
- 5. In addition to the requirements of the MN Hockey Screening Policy, HHA will mandate that any Locker Room Monitor will complete the MN Hockey Screening Form (online or paper copy).
- 6. Parents who do not complete the MN Hockey Screening Form will not be allowed into the locker room for any reason.
