- Friday, June 15th:** Returning player registration form and full registration deposit due to hold a spot in the league.
- USA Hockey registrations must be done by the individual at www.usahockey.com. USA hockey opens registration for the 2012/2013 season on or around May 1, 2012. Confirmation may accompany registration before a player is allowed on the ice.
- Travel tryout fees are required at the time of registration (\$50 per level).
- Friday, August 3rd: DEADLINE TO ADD TRAVEL TRYOUTS**
- TBD: TRAVEL TRYOUTS**
- Week of September 4th: Squirt Travel Skill sessions begin**
- Week of September 24th: RECREATION ON-ICE EVALUATIONS**
- October 31st:** Travel and Recreation league fee balance due. You will receive an invoice for all remaining league fees (travel and recreation) that will be due **Wednesday, October 31, 2012**. All players are expected to pay in full on October 31st. Any player that has not paid in full will not be permitted to participate in any AYHL activities and will not be allowed to return until all fees are paid in full. **NEW THIS YEAR...Your credit card will automatically be charged the remaining balance on October 31st with the credit card you used to pay the initial deposit.**

RECREATION 8 & UNDER

- The Recreation League will run from early October through the end of March.
- Teams generally practice on a consistent day and time.
- 3 practices: 1 game ratio, stressing participation, fun and skill development.

RECREATION SQUIRT-MIDGET

- The Recreation League will run from early October through the end of March.
- Recreation Playoffs will begin immediately following the regular season.
- Teams generally practice on a consistent day and time.
- Practices will begin no earlier than 4 pm and end no later than 10:30 pm.

TRAVEL

- Travel Tryouts will begin on or about **August 17th**. Times will vary according to level.

SQUIRT TRAVEL

Season Length (Start/Stop Dates)

- Association may run skills & drills/small area games/cross-ice games beginning September 4th, 2012 for all Squirts
 - Associations select teams the week of September 24th.
- League game season may run from October 12, 2012 to March 2013.
- An average of 3 to 4 ice sessions per week over 6 month season.
- Maximum of 45 games per team which includes league, non league & tournament games. Excludes possible playoffs & games with girls' teams.
- Squirts may attend a maximum of 1 out of state tournament per season.

Game Procedures

- Game lengths should be 60 minutes in length – 3 12 minute stop periods.
- Maximum 15 skaters & 1-2 goalies per team.

Player Selection

A, B & C Divisions as CCYHL currently fields. Player selection remains as is currently done by associations.

AYHL will be conducting skills sessions two to three times a week for the squirt age players through September (dates to TBA). Teams will then be selected the week of September 24th. If your child is interested in playing on a competitive squirt team they will need to sign up, through the registration form, for the skill sessions at a cost of \$100 per player.
