An appropriate question to ask yourself prior to making a nomination would be "How has this individual made my softball experience better than what I anticipated...?" Eligible league members may submit the name of one individual for each season's PEGI award. Nomination forms that are not complete or nominations for individuals that are not eligible for the award will be disqualified.
