## **Charitable Gambling (License #02059)**

## **Gambling Manager Position**

This is a paid position. The Gambling Manager is the person who is in charge of day-to-day activities of the organization's gambling operation. The Gambling Manager must:

Be licensed by the Minnesota Gambling Control Board
Have a \$10,000 bond
Have attended a Gambling Manager seminar and passed a written test
Attend a continuing education class every calendar year

## The Gambling Manager duties include but are not limited to:

- 1. Attending and presenting the current and budgeted income/expense figures at the monthly Lakeville Hockey Association board meeting
- 2. Completing and filing monthly charitable gambling tax returns
- 3. Assuring that the organization is in compliance with all statutes and rules related to lawful gambling
- 4. Reviewing and monitoring the conduct of games
- 5. Supervising and disciplining gambling employees
- 6. Ensuring all receipts and disbursements have been properly accounted for in compliance with statute and rule requirements
- 7. Processing payroll and filing monthly, quarterly and annual taxes
- 8. Ensuring that all inventory records have been reconciled each month
- 9. Supervising all licensing and reporting requirements
- 10. Assuring that illegal gambling is not conducted at a permitted premise
