- MN Hockey Executive Director, Mike Snee resigned. Search underway for replacement who could work with corporate people.

- Level 4 clinic- Last one in Minnesota. Do <u>NOT</u> accept waivers. Will need to go out of State if miss out.

- Hutchinson outside tryout group question- Answer: those groups need to be screened prior to being on ice with kids.


All 3 divisions in each level merge for playoffs
