


## **Add an Internet Calendar Subscription**


An Internet Calendar Subscription is a calendar that you download and view in Outlook. However, unlike a Calendar Snapshot, Internet Calendar Subscriptions are updated automatically. So if the scheduler or coach changes the event on the Casco Bay website, it will automatically update on your local calendar where you have installed the iCal feed.

## **Subscribe to an Internet Calendar in Outlook**


- 1. Navigate to the team page whose calendar you want to hook to.
- 2. Find the "View all button" on the bottom of the team calendar previews that are listed on each Casco Bay team's page (See red circle below)



3. When you click on "View All" the team's full calendar will open, and look like the below. You will now click on the "Subscribe to iCal Feed" button on the bottom right of the full calendar (see red circle below).



4. A window with a url address for the iCal feed and directions on how to install it will open up, like this:



5. Follow the above steps for each individual team that you would like to have auto synch with your Outlook calendar.

## **Subscribe to calendars in Google Calendar**

To add a calendar using its address from the page above, follow these steps:

- 1. In Google calendar, click the down-arrow next to **Other calendars**
- 2. Select **Add by URL** from the menu
- 3. <u>Find the address</u> of the Google Calendar in <u>iCalendar format</u>, or if you have the iCalendar address of a calendar from a different application (for example, Apple's iCal), you can use this as well.
- 4. Enter the address in the field provided
- 5. Click the **Add Calendar** button. The calendar will appear in the **Other Calendars** section of the calendar list to the left.
