Secretary's Report – Sarah Schilling: RRude motion to approve September minutes with noted revision, second by DNauss and motion carries unanimously.

President's Report – Greg Gibson: The Wayzata CMS locker room updates are underway; additional WYHA donation to School District 284 planned for 12/10 school board meeting.
