## **How to Register**

Greetings hockey fans! There will be some changes for the 2013-14 hockey season. The Maine Amateur Hockey Association is requiring all players to register online. In order to do this, you need to go to the USA hockey website for player registration:

You will enter information about your child and have to submit a \$40 fee for USA membership and \$12 for Maine membership for a grand total of \$52. You will need a credit card to accomplish this task. The remainder of \$250.00 can be submitted with your other materials at registration.

There is no charge, for either USA Hockey or Maine AHA, for children 6 and under. However, you must register online anyway. Fees for the IP group are \$85.00.

Once you have registered online, you will receive an email from USA hockey confirming your membership. We will need a copy of that email. You can either forward it to <a href="mailto:piyhreg@gmail.com">piyhreg@gmail.com</a> or send it with the remainder of your registration materials (health information sheet, player and parent code of conduct) and a check for \$250.00.
