Meeting Minutes

1. IP Program

Aaron Stellmach: Attended a meeting in Richmond to discuss several items: ADM Model, Philosophy, practice plans, groupings of players

Kimberly Cremers was present as well: She stated that some of the Mite parents felt short changed with practice times. They had three practices last year. PDC stated that Mites have not lost any ice only that they are sharing the ice with termites. With ADM the ice time is utilized better with more reps per kid.

Game situations: Kids should NOT be scrimmaging until after January and full ice scrimmages should not be taking place.

3. Goalie Concerns:
