- Experienced some frustrations with the age coordinators, i.e. equipment not being turned in

- Avoid Wildwood for field usage (poor field conditions)
- Quality coaches needed for inhouse teams, possible to hire high school players? wouldn't have the same conflicts as parent coaches, arranging payment might be a challenge
- Suggested having different format for practices - 1 higher level coach to instruct 4 teams, then break out into separate teams to practice skill that was instructed. Tactical play to be covered in individual team format

Director of Coaching Report: Kevin Kielsa -

- For winter training the first week saw 40 boys \& 35 girls.
- For January/February and March/April sessions, could we open up to U7s \& U8s? Kevin will put together a recommendation on how best to do this
- Kevin would like to see more skill training in future sessions (not free play)
- MYSA Symposium scheduled for Saturday, Feb. $2^{\text {nd }}$ (all day).
- Motion made for us to go as a group (\$600). Have had many coaches attend in the past \& benefit from attending - motion passes.
- Fee structure meeting needed in early December (non board meeting time) - Julio will schedule this meeting and will include Jay Breidinger
- Need to have fee structure in place before registration for spring season
- Kimberly P. asked if having Micro players be a part of winter training
- Town Hall meeting in the works to help promote sense of community, give parents an opportunity to ask questions and also look for more parents willing to volunteer. Meeting place needed - Ben L. suggested using his church space
- Asked if possible to post job openings we have on the home page of our website

## NEW BUSINESS

## Team Formation Council

- Could use a few more members - will be meeting in early December.
- Suggested that the name of this council gives false impression as to what they actually do
- "Soccer Development Council" offered up as a better name
- Council will report their findings to the board
- Most important (time urgent) is the building of younger teams
- Could possibly use registration as a tool to find volunteer parents


## Evaluations Committee

- The Director of Coaching (DOC) and the Director of Player Development (DOPD) make up the basis of this committee but report to the President.
- Need to limit number of people involved in team formation
- Independent evaluators needed (\& how do we find them outside of Mahtomedi)
- Need to limit the task to those who get paid for it
- Not just a two-person decision however; overseen by the President
- Two-day evaluation period not feasible - need to look at players over a long time frame (winter training)
- Evaluation should be a sum total, not just a snapshot in time


## Volunteering: Kimberly Peterson

- Our club is in need of great volunteers - a "Town Hall" style meeting would be one way to find parents to volunteer. Kimberly will make arrangements for this meeting
- Fundraisers are another one (wine tastings, gold outings, etc.)
- Example of hockey given, saying that they do typically 4 events each year and raise close to \$50,000
- Suggested a fundraising committee be formed
- Apparel is another way to fundraise (hockey uses Letterman Sports for apparel) - hockey uses sponsorship as a way to fundraise
- For hockey $\$ 150$ gets company name on back of jersey
- $\$ 600$ gets name on web page, jersey and billboard
- Suggested that younger teams use tee shirts for uniforms
- Suggested that a podium be built at the high school fields to put sponsor names on and use as a background for photos for trophy-winning teams

Tournament Director urgently needed - Belinda Hanson and Jon Nelson both mentioned as possible candidates. (Jon mentioned he was interested in helping with fundraising)
