

Class Policy with regards to Ice Usage and Safety:

The Skating Association of Maine holds “Booster” Lessons and “Introduction to Figure Skating” Class on one designated hour at Waterville, Sawyer and MRC. Classes are advertised differently in each Basic Skills Program.

These “Classes” are advertised in our program brochures; advertised classes and safety of these skaters are priority

- A Walk-On ice fee is to be collected by the lesson coach before the skaters steps on the ice (if not already pre-paid) and given to the Director (or designated coach in event Director is not there) to be recorded.
- The skater on the ice whether “booster” or “private” lesson is only on the ice while with a coach in lesson. Skater may not stay on ice after lesson to practice.
- Booster lessons take priority over a private lesson
- A “private” lesson skater wishing to take a private lesson on class ice needs to be currently contracting ice with the Skating Association of Maine
- No programs played or full moves patterns skated (small concentration elements of moves may be worked on)
- Right of way to Introduction to Figure Skating Class, Booster Lesson and any other advertised class listed in the brochure
- At any time if there are complaints from “class” parents or “booster” parents that private lessons are disruptive or there are any safety concerns then the director may re-evaluate the safety of the ice
- “Private” lessons may be given on class ice when there are less than 2 freestyle sessions in total offered for that program.
