PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

As a parent/legal guardian of a child involved in a program of Eastern Virginia Hockey League (EVHL), I agree to abide by and follow the rules and guidelines below.

*I will not coach my child(ren) during practices and games or shout at my child on the ice, in the dressing room, or during team activities.

*I will encourage my child(ren) to play by the rules, work hard during practices to develop skills, de-emphasize winning scores and emphasize healthy competition.

*I will set a good example for their child(ren) by learning the rules of hockey and by being good sports that never boo or heckle game events, players or officials.

*I will set a good example for their child(ren) by supporting the coaches and game officials and by acting appropriately regardless of the outcome of the game on the scoreboard.

*I will emphasize and demand zero tolerance for drug, alcohol, cigarettes or other substance use or abuse.

*I will emphasize and demand zero tolerance for poor sportsmanship and for theft or destruction of rink or other property.

***Profanity and abusive language toward any other parent, coach or referee will not be tolerated and will result in: 1st offense – warning to concerned party, 2nd offense – 30 day suspension of the concerned party. 3rd offense – the concerned party will be banned from the IcePlex during any EVHL events for the remainder of the season and there will be no refund issued. The Disciplinary Committee will be notified of the offense (by coach or parent), verify it, and issue the disciplinary action.**

***All EVHL teams must abide by a coaches (24) hour rule. The rule states that no parent, relative, guardian or friend can make contact with any coach for discussions on a game situation for (24) hours after the game ending. The concerned party must contact the team manager to schedule a meeting with the coach after the completion of the (24) hour period. The meeting must be scheduled within 7 days or before the next season game. Violation of the (24) hour rule will result in: 1st offense – warning to parent, 2nd offense – 30 day suspension of the concerned party. 3rd offense – the concerned party will be banned from the IcePlex during any and all EVHL events for the remainder of the season and there will be no refund issued. The Disciplinary Committee will be notified of the offense, verify it, and issue the disciplinary action.**

I understand that by signing this document I am agreeing to support and promote this Parent/Legal Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement. Further, my failure to comply with this Agreement or my participation in any of the defined CONDUCT SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE will result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from the EVHL.
