- 2. Any issue involving physical altercations, assault or battery (as defined in the STYSA Discipline, Protest, Grievance and Appeal Procedures) of any players, referees, coaches, administrators or parents.

Such offenses can lead to removal from the premises and a ban from the soccer facilities for the remainder of the season and/or permanently.

I agree to have my behavior subjected to the highest standards in order to protect the players, trainers, referees, administrators and volunteers of NBYSA.

I understand and agree that any behavior in conflict with the NBYSA Zero Tolerance Policy will not be accepted and will subject me to penalties.
