MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The Champlin Park High School has established a mentorship program with Champlin Park Youth Hockey Association. This program offers the opportunity for the high school players to develop leadership skills as they mentor and become role models for the youth program.

How the program works:

- A group of players is assigned by the Varsity Coach to mentor a youth team.
- Players will individually contact the Head Coach by December 1st to introduce themselves and set up an initial time to skate with the team in December.
- Each player will talk to the head coach to schedule all ice times to skate with the team over the course of the team's season. (December thru February)
- Team Managers will provide the players with a Game Schedule.
- Players will attend some games and also spend time with the team before and after the games.
- All players are asked to invite the team to come to the high school games.

Expectations of high school players:

- All players will wear their hockey helmet (with chin strap secured) and gloves on the ice.
- All players will wear Rebel colors on the ice.
- All players will actively participate in the practices.
- Players will follow the directions of the coaching staff on how to work with the team.
- Players that are not actively helping with practice can be asked to leave by the Head Coach.
- All Players are expected to volunteer 8 hours over the three month season attending practices and games.
- No high school players are allowed on the bench or ice during games. (They are occasional helpers and not coaches.)

Expectation of CPYHA Coaches/Managers:

- Welcome the players to your team.
- Provide direction as to how you want to use the players in practices.
- Provide positive feedback to the players on how they are working with your team.
- Address any problem issues promptly.
- Coordinate a schedule with the player, but remember, they are student athletes with busy schedules.
- Encourage your team to come and watch the CPHS Varsity and Jr. Varsity games and cheer for "your players".
