There are at least one or two teams at each grade level that would otherwise have been ranked below, but are not, because of Rule B-11. We have, however, made exceptions for teams that played in at least two strong meets last season and have made a more significant commitment to the League for the 2012-2013 season.

Teams that dropped in the rankings from the season before shouldn't necessarily feel that they have regressed. At each grade level, we added several teams for the 2011-2012 season.
