Motion passed to accept minutes from previous meeting

Treasurer:

A budget is needed ASAP

John Boyle is a possibility to do the budget or contract out to an accounting firm to do the budget JB would charge \$50/hr (up to 40 hrs/week) to be done by end of January at the latest JB cannot do day-to-day treasurer duties

We need to be in compliance to maintain our non-profit status

Gather a group of board members to go through receipts and sort so we can move ahead in an organized manner

Possible to put winter training on online registration

Hoping to open spring registration in Nov/Dec to maximize time allowance and allow those families who want to do the payment plan to be able to do so

Dibs is ready to go now. Possible to use for the tournament, need to identify jobs in advance and could use it as needs arise

Could be used for inhouse management (coaching, managing, etc.) as well

Director of Coaching Update: Kevin Kielsa

Traveling Coaches - U11 and up are paid coaches

Head coaches of these traveling teams receive \$1800 for spring/summer season & \$800 for fall season.

In House report:

All registrations are in (lots of late registrants)

Was suggested to state ahead of time that the inhouse players "be split by age if possible"

Sanneh Foundation: Dave Golan

Partnerships with clubs can be tailored to fit specific needs within the club.

Camps are offered for college ID for players.

Skills camps are offered for younger players (life skills too, depending on club need)

Foundation works with youth in Haiti.

Foundation helps raise money to bring players from other countries; team who raises the most money gets a trip to MLS game

Foundation can offer college recruiting seminar (basics). In return they ask those players to help staff summer camps (U14 and older)

Equipment collection is a big program for the foundation.

Camp program a big program for suburban clubs (college ID camps too)

Foundation offers an overnight camp at Gustavus. Club would receive money back from camp registrations.

Overnight camps are for ages 12 - 18 (or possibly 14 - 18).

Fundraising: Kimberly Peterson

Working on sponsors for next spring; some are involved with Homecoming Will receive close to \$1800 from Picture Place from fall picture night. Will receive money back from Lettermans as well.

Winter Training: Mike Dunham

Joaquin would like to have a coaches meeting to explain expectations, training, etc. Joaquin expressed frustration with behavior at DOPD trainings this fall.

Joaquin would like to run winter training himself and his staff and have coaches attend to learn.

Joaquin expressed that there is difficulty in combining lower & higher level players and would like to avoid this if possible.

Winter training should be done by team whenever possible, with 2 trainers plus the coach from the team. Optimal training is 1.5 to 2 hrs per session.

We are looking into additional places to train (St Andrews?) as well as training after school.

This winter we need to charge per player by facility space & per session (fees TBD).

Tentative schedule due out in the next couple of weeks (Mike D).
