2013 14U SUPER LEAGUE RULES

- #1 All teams <u>MUST</u> bat their entire line-up for the entire season. (NOTE: <u>This includes the end of</u> season tournament).
- #2 If short players, teams may borrow players from within their leagues to fill out teams. Only a minimum league age 12 girl rostered in your own league is eligible to borrow.
- #3 Other than bat-around entire line-up, there are no blanket pitching, position or playing time restrictions. Teams are only required to abide by their own individual league rotation and pitching rules (if any).
- #4 A courtesy runner (i.e. the last out) shall be allowed only for the catcher <u>after</u> there are two outs. This is intended only to speed up the game.
- #5 Games are seven innings or 1hr 30min, no new inning, whichever comes first.
- #6 Per inning run limit = 6 per team, until the last inning(s) (see #9 below). There is no runs ahead (i.e. Mercy) rule; all games will be played regardless of the score.
- #7 Game Balls: Home team supplies new game ball and good back up ball ("Worth" Leather Dream Seam).
- #8 Home team supplies and pays the umpire.
- #9 The umpire will announce an open inning in the last inning, for which there will be no run limits. Because of time limits, there is a possibility of more than one open inning to end a game. If no open inning is announced by the umpire prior to the first pitch of the inning, the entire inning is subject to the 6 run limit per team. Both head coaches may agree, prior to the start of the game in the pre-game meeting with the umpire, to waive this rule and enforce the 6 run limit per team per inning throughout the entire game. This waiver must be agreed to by both head coaches prior to the start of the game; otherwise this rule shall be enforced.
- #10 Pitching plates are at a distance of 43 feet.
- #11 Metal cleats are NOT allowed.

#12 End of the Season Tournament:

- Flip coin for Home/Visitor. Dugout side- first come first serve
- One umpire for all Playoff Games and Championship game
- Must bat entire line-up
- Playoff Games are seven innings or 1hr 30min, no new inning, whichever comes first.
 Championship Game seven innings, no time limit
- Per inning run limit = 6.....Open inning in the 7th inning of Tournament Games only
- Umpire is paid in cash and split between teams playing each game (ex: \$25.00 ea = \$50)
- Game balls: 1 brand new game ball supplied by each team ("Worth" Leather Dream Seam)
