Monticello Baseball Association MBA Constitution and Bylaws

Amended 11/30/2004

1. ORGANIZATION

The name of this organization is the Monticello Baseball Association

2. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of the Monticello Baseball Association is to support and encourage growth and development of youth baseball in Monticello MN.

3. MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the Monticello Baseball Association is open to all interested adults and graduating seniors of Monticello Public Schools. Membership dues are included in the player registration fee. All other memberships may be purchased at \$5.00 per family or \$3.00 per individual.

4. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A. President:

The President is responsible for presiding over all business meetings of the Monticello Baseball Association. The President is also responsible for organizing and selecting committees to assist with various operations and functions of the Monticello Baseball

Association.

B. Vice-President:

The Vice-President will act to preside over all business meetings in the absence of the President of the Monticello Baseball Association. In the event that the President is unable to fulfill his duties during his term, the Vice President will assume the responsibilities of the President.

C. Secretary:

The Secretary will record the minutes of each meeting and notify the public through various media of all events relating to the Monticello Baseball Association. The Secretary will also coordinate any special events involving the MBA.

D. Treasurer:

The Treasurer will make appropriate deposits and withdrawals in the MBA checking or savings account/accounts. The Treasurer will be an authorized signor of checks for the MBA.

5. ELECTIONS

Revision: 11/30/04

Elections will be conducted annually to fill any position whereby that member has completed his/her 2 year term or has vacated his/her position on the Board of Directors. Elections will be held during the Annual Membership Meeting and will be determined by Popular Vote of all MBA Members attending. All candidates will be allowed to state their credentials during the Annual Membership Meeting and if nominated by any MBA Member, will be added to the ballot. A majority vote by the MBA members present at the Annual Membership Meeting will determine the winner(s).

All officers of the MBA will be nominated and voted on by the Board of Directors at the first Board Meeting following the annual Membership Meeting. The President will only vote on officer elections in case of a tie.

6. REGULAR BUSINESS

Upon notification of all the Directors and/or Membership, regular business of the MBA can be conducted and agreed upon with 50% of the Board of Directors present at their meetings and/or a majority of the membership present at the Membership Meetings.

7. AMENDMENTS

Amendments to these bylaws of the MBA can be voted upon and approved by a majority of the voting membership present.
