Policy/Procedure: Registration Fees – Policy T

Approved: September 2000

Revised: July 2001, September 2002, June 2004, August 2019, August 2025

It is one of the goals of the AYHA to keep registration fees as low as possible so that youngsters are not prevented from playing hockey due to cost.

Each year the AYHA will review the registration fees and determine the fees for the upcoming hockey season based upon projected operating expenses and other income.

Family Maximum:

- Families with 2 players will receive a 10% discount for each player in the family
- Families with 3 players will receive a 15% discount for each player in the family
- Families with more than 3 players receive a 25% discount for each player in the family.

To qualify for the family maximum discount, all players in the family MUST be registered and paid in full at the same time.

New players involved for the first time in organized hockey at the Pee wee level or below will receive a 50% discount off the normal fee for that level.

For families who have first time hockey players, they have the choice of taking the 50% new player discount or the family max discount.

Returning families who register after a fundraiser for that season has been completed will be charged the appropriate buyout amount.

The Registrar, in conjunction with the Treasurer, has the authority to reduce the registration fee for a player by applying funds that have been donated or put aside to help the player/family who is not able to pay the full amount of the registration fee(s).

For High School players, the AYHA will forward 20% of all registration fees to the Blue Line Club and will retain the balance of the fee.

All families are required to pay their registration fees or make arrangements for payment of fees before the 1st organized team practice. **If money is due to the AYHA from the past season, players will NOT be allowed to register or participate in any AYHA activities until all fees or money past due is paid in full.**

Senior Year Registration:

All skaters entering their final year with AYHA (Senior year) are required to pay their entire registration fee at time of registration. Skaters will not be allowed to participate in organized practices until their balance is paid in full.

Fundraising Credits:

Families are responsible for requesting any applicable fundraising credit. If credit is owed, it must be requested at the time of registration. Once the registration balance has been paid in full, the credit will be applied accordingly or refunded to the card used at registration.

Please note that fundraising credits will not be applied retroactively if a request is not made during the registration process.

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Refunds of registration fees after team splitting will not be permitted except for medical reasons substantiated by a letter from a medical doctor. Refunds due to medical reasons will be made as follows:

Date of Medical Letter	Amount of Refund
Splits – December 31 st	Full Registration minus USA Hockey Insurance Fee
January 1 st – January 31 st	2/3 Registration minus USA Hockey Insurance Fee
February 1 st – March 1 st	1/3 Registration minus USA Hockey Insurance Fee
After March 1 st	No Refund

**No refund will be given except for registration. No refund will be given if the player or any other player in the family owes any other fees to the association.
