NOTE: Please read the following bullets before completing this form:

- If you have not read the posting on the website entitled "Enrollment Information and Timeline for
  the Spring 2024 WIVL Season," please go back and read it before completing this form. It contains
  valuable background information you'll need to complete this form.
- While this form is designed so that each Community/Association can complete one form that covers all of its teams' play dates and host dates for all age levels (grades 4/5, 6, 7 and 8), enrolling communities can submit separate forms for each grade, or combination of grades. If you are registering a team separate from others in your Community/Association, please note that fact in the "Comments" section at the end of Question #1.

2) Coaches Name(s), Address and Phone Number(s). We need a list of all your coaches, with their mailing address, various phone numbers, e-mail address, etc. Provide as much information as possible. For those teams where you plan to name a coach at a later date, write "To Be Determined," and get that information to us as soon as possible. It is critical that we have a complete listing of all coaches before the season starts for purposes of communicating schedule changes, confirmation calls/e-mails, etc.

Please use the "Coach/Contact" attachment at the end of this Enrollment Form (pages 8-15) to provide that information. If you have more than one team at a particular grade level or want to list more than two coaches per team, please use the last section of the attachment or an additional piece of paper.

3) **Number of Play Dates and Matches at Each Play Date.** For the Spring 2024 season, we will have a separate division for these three grades: 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Teams in 5<sup>th</sup> grade, 4<sup>th</sup> grade and combined 5<sup>th</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade teams, will again play in a combined 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> grade division. As described in detail in the post accompanying this Enrollment Form and Section B-4 of the Rules, teams will have the option of playing three, four, five or more matches per day.

Meets will be scheduled on ten consecutive Saturdays: March 9, March 16, March 23, March 30, April 6, April 13, April 20, April 27, May 4 and May 11 (regular meets for 6<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade teams and League Championship Tournaments for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams). Teams can play as few or as many of those dates as they want.

For each team, list the number of meets in which they want to play (the first blank after the team name) and the number of matches they would like to play at each meet (the second blank in each line). If you have a specific request, please detail that in the comments section below. However, don't exaggerate a team's unavailability. For example, when playing the minimum three matches at each meet, if a team always insists on playing in the morning, but could play in the afternoon, saying they are absolutely unavailable in the afternoon means they will have fewer play dates and longer travel, because not every team can be blocked into the same specific time slot every week.

**8<sup>th</sup> Grade and 7<sup>th</sup> Grade League Championship Tournament.** LCTs will be held on Saturday, May 11, for 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams and 7<sup>th</sup> grade teams only. Regular meets will be scheduled for teams in 6<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> grade divisions. For details on how the LCT will be formatted and the LCT fee, please see Section B-7 of the rules posted on the League website (*gnbl.org*), click on the "Volleyball League" tab, then on "2024 Rules."

Note: If a 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade team plans to play in the League Championship on May 11, that tournament <u>will count</u> as one of your play dates. For example, if a team wants to play in four regular meets through May 4, <u>plus</u> the LCT, they should indicate that they want to play **five total** meets. If another team wants to play in four meets through May 4, but does <u>not</u> want to play in the LCT, they should indicate that they want to play **four total meets**.

Play Date Availability. Since the season is only ten weeks long and since most teams will probably play in three meets or more, we encourage you to make your teams available on **as many** of the ten play dates as possible. Before answering this question, get the input of your coaches for specific teams so that you aren't scheduling their team on a date that coach will be unavailable. If you do not know who your coaches will be for some or all of the teams, you won't know for sure if they have any conflicts on possible League play dates.

Listed horizontally below are the ten dates on which meets will be played. Please write "YES" in the box for each date that each team is available to play. Write "NO" on those dates when that team absolutely cannot play. If you do not write anything in one or more boxes, we will presume that you cannot play on that date.

Conflicts for Coaches Dealing with More than One Team. Describe any special scheduling needs
your team(s) have, such as coaches who coach multiple teams, teams that must travel to the same
location, etc. Do not exaggerate those needs or it may unnecessarily curtail the play date options for
one or more teams. Please be aware that the League reserves the right to limit the number of
matches for teams needing to be scheduled in the same location in opposite time slots. In many
cases, it is not possible to allow two teams of the same grade to play in opposite time slots – in other
words, coaching two teams of the same grade and wanting no overlapping matches may not be
possible and the total number of matches for each team will be reduced when needed. Please also
indicate whether you would want to have only one team play in a meet or would prefer to play fewer
matches for each team if it is necessary.

4) **Team Experience Level.** When organizing meets in the 2024 season, the League will schedule some meets placing teams of similar ability levels at the same location. This will **not** be the case in all meets because it would mean less experienced, but talented, teams may have fewer opportunities to play more experienced teams. It would also lead to many teams playing each other several times in the season. Please indicate below the experience level of your team:

5) **Host Dates.** If your community has two playing surfaces available on a given Saturday, you will be able to host for one grade. If you have three, four or more available playing surfaces, you can host for two or possibly more grades. Note that with the "flexible" scheduling procedure outlined in Section B-3 of the rules, a community can have two or more teams at the same grade level play at home in the same meet and not be scheduled to play each other.

While most seasons we have been able to balance supply and demand so that we have had enough meets to accommodate the preferences of all teams on number of play dates, that hasn't always been easy. See Rule B-5 for an explanation of how playing space will be rationed if we have too few host dates and, conversely, how hosting opportunities will be limited if there is an excess of events relative to demand.

If you prefer to host a meet for a particular grade (4/5, 6, 7 or 8) on a particular date, please indicate this below. While we will attempt to honor preferences as to which grades you host on which dates, the League needs the flexibility to select among those dates in which your community has gyms available to best accommodate the League's overall meet schedule. Be liberal in designating dates you can host – we need more than one option from each community to have maximum flexibility. For instance, we can't have meets in Merrill and Antigo, or Hayward and Webster on the same date.

Before you submit this form, please reserve your top preferred dates with your school administration so that these dates are locked in. In that way, if we need to try to switch a date later, you have something to trade. If you don't reserve any of these days, you may have nothing firmly available when we finalize the schedule.
