- Game balls will be provided. All Grades levels will use 28.5 ball.
- Please bring your own basketballs for warm-ups and put them away when not in use. No basketballs allowed anywhere else in the buildings. No dribbling or shooting unless your team is on the court for a game.
- Please keep your fans and children off of the court at all times.
- Southland Youth Basketball is not liable for a) any injury occurring at or during the tournament, or b) any possessions or articles lost at or during the tournament.
- Each team is responsible for supplying and administering its own first aid.


## Tournament Rules

I. MAXIMUMTWO COACHS ON BENCHFOR EACH TEAM.THISWILBESTRICTLY ENFORCED.
2. Minnesota High School League Rules govern except as noted below.
3. 5 minute grace period opening game only. We will let schedule run ahead if possible. Do not leave the premises within an hour of your start times.
4. Pre-game warm-ups will be 3:00 minutes. Half time will be 3:00 minutes.
5. Team roster must be turned into the scoring table before each game. Players may "play up" as many grades as desired but may not "play down" a grade.
6. I8 minute running halves. Clock will stop on the following
a. shooting fouls (clock stops on whistle and re-starts on first free throw);
b. team time outs and official time outs;
c. all whistles during the last two minutes of each half.
7. (2) 30 -second time outs per half and one per overtime. No carry over.
8. First OT is two-minute stop-time regular play. Second OT is sudden death. Jump ball to start each OT.
9. Technical Fouls will result in automatic two points and possession at mid-court.
10. $4^{\text {th }}, 5^{\text {th }}$, and $6^{\text {th }}$ Grade Defense
a. half court man-to-man with 'help and recover' (no zone, excessive sagging, or double teaming);
b. full court man-to-man allowed last two minutes of each half unless leading by 10 or more;
c. after one warning from officials, illegal defenses will result in a technical foul.
II. $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ Grade Defense
a. all defenses allowed at all times except no full court defense when leading by 10 or more.
12. 3-point shots will be allowed on all courts for all grades.
13. Tie Breakers: a) head-to-head result; b) total point differential (up to 15 per game); c) 5-player free throw shootout with one shot each; if still tied then one player rounds until tie is broken (similar to hockey).
14. Superior Sportsmanship is required from all coaches, players, and fans. Un-sportsmanlike conduct will be cause for ejection from the game and possibly the tournament.
