



# BOYS YOUTH BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT 2014

Saturday February 22<sup>nd</sup> ----- 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Grades  
Sunday February 23<sup>th</sup> ----- 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grades

We are looking forward to seeing you all in Austin. Please familiarize yourselves with the rules and sites so there is no confusion. We depend on your punctuality to keep on schedule.

## **RULES, etc.**

1. 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade games will be two - 18 minute running clock halves except for the last two minutes of first half and end of game. Time stops only for time outs. All other games (6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup>) will be two 14 minutes halves. Stop time.
2. Half time will be 4 minutes unless tournament is running behind.
3. Two one minute time outs per half. One time out per overtime. No carryovers
4. Overtimes are 2 minutes. If necessary 2<sup>nd</sup> overtime will be sudden death except in medal rounds
5. One and one after 7<sup>th</sup> team foul and 2 shots after 10<sup>th</sup> team foul
6. Technical fouls-two points and the ball
7. **4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> divisions MUST play man-to-man defense.** NO DOUBLE TEAM except if a player is driving to basket. **6<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>: All defenses allowed**
8. 4<sup>th</sup> grade – no press allowed at all - no help defense
9. 5<sup>th</sup> grade – Press is allowed the last two minutes of the half unless the team that is ahead is up by 20 points or more. Then only the trailing team can press the last two minutes.
10. 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> – press IS allowed any time unless leading by 20 or more points
11. All grades – running clock if a team is leading by 20 or more points. Clock continues unless lead drops under 15 points
12. 4 or 6 team division tie breakers – Record---Points allowed---Points scored---Coin toss
13. All other Minnesota State High School League rules apply
14. Teams provide their own warm up balls
15. Officials' decisions are final. Coaches: You are expected to conduct yourselves professionally.
16. ADMISSION: Adults – \$5.00 Students/Seniors - \$3.00 Coaches/players free
17. Tournament directors will be on site if you have questions
18. **Individual awards will be given to 12 players 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place (plus Consolation in 8 and 10 team brackets)**
19. **Finally, AYB reserves the right to refuse any team consisting of players from multiple school districts (All Star team).**

COACHES, PLAYERS AND FANS ARE EXPECTED TO EXHIBIT GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP THROUGHOUT THE TOURNAMENT.
