Pool Tie Breakers / Extra Pool Games / Forfeits

Tie Breakers

Two Way Tie: Head to Head. In a two way tie the team that won in the head to head match up advances.

<u>Three Way Tie:</u> Points Scored (15 pts is most for one win). The team with the most points scored during their pool play games advances. If there is a two way tie with total number of points, then it breaks down to Head to Head between those two teams and the winner advances.

Extra Pool Games

<u>During a pool of 5 or 7 (Super Pools):</u> One team usually has to be scheduled for an extra game, so all teams in pool receive 3 pool play games. The extra game that the team is scheduled to play for the extra pool play game (which would give that team 4 games) does NOT count for them or against them. Only the first 3 games scheduled count towards Championship play. The 4th game does not count for that team, but that game is the 3rd game for one of the teams in the pool and will count for that team towards Championship play.

Forfeits

Game time is forfeit time. There is no grace period. The team that forfeits will receive a Loss and -15 points. The team that wins because of forfeit receives a Win +15 points.
