

ABOUT CAITLIN WELCH

Caitlin Welch has had a tremendous volleyball career from the day she started playing. She is a local who attended Mercy Academy and played as the team's varsity libero since she was a freshman. Caitlin won two state championships at Mercy, receiving Region Player of the year and Most Valuable Player her senior year. As an 8 year old, she tried out for MidAmerica Volleyball Association (MAVA) unaware that she would be a player on the 12-1 team. She was a participant for MAVA for 10 straight years up to her final year at 18's. Caitlin won a national championship at USAV's Junior Olympics in 2008 and was also a finalist in 2007. She was named to the All-Tournament Team for five years in a row and was listed on PrepVolleyball's Top 10 Defensive Dandies for two years. At the age of sixteen, Caitlin committed to the University of Louisville where she received a full athletic scholarship. While playing at Louisville, she was a 4-year starting Libero, earning awards and breaking many records. She was named to the All-Tournament team at four different collegiate tournaments. Her Junior year, she became the All Time digs leader in a season. Shortly after, she broke the All-Time digs record. She earned her 1,000th dig in her Junior year and her 2,000th dig a year later.
